This is a letter from our friend Bill in Cannon Beach to his friend Keith in Texas.

To'd like to share it with you. It reflects some of the anger and frustration that many of us here in Oregon feel about the coming election and especially Measure 13.

Dear Keith;

What a joy to have your letter today telling us how much your summer in Cannon Beach meant to you and something about your present life away

from us back here.

We have all sorts of things to tell but the over riding concern here is the upcoming election on November 8th. Not only do we have to watch from afar races like the one in Texas for the governorship and the race between Oliver North and Charles Robb, but we have a lot of local races and ballot measures in Oregon the outcome of which could strongly impact what you think you have left behind. There are some more than slightly unsavory candidates for the position of mayor of Cannon Beach, for U.S. Congress from our district, and for Covernor of Oregon. Most serious of all however, from our point of view, is Ballot Measure 13, sponsored by the Oregon Citizens Alliance. One of the reasons I'm skimming right along is that I already know that by now you can sense what we are really talking about all along is the CHRISTIANWHITEIS RIGHTTRADITIONALFAMILYVALUESAMERICAN WAYFLACWAVINGCROSSOFJESUSISLORDANDKING OFTHEWHITEMALEPATRIARCALIRRATIONAL AUTHORITARIANRIGIDGUNBEARINGBIGOTBUT WON TADMITIT PARTY vs. the rest of us.

The most recent confection of this band of FLAT EARTH SOCIETY CRETINS is that gays in Germany caused the Holocaust during the Third Reich!!! This is especially galling because so many thousands of gays were forced to wear Pink Triangles and were put to death in the camps in Europe along with Jews, gypsies, the mentally ill, the handicapped and any other sub-group which the NAZIS deemed to be undesirable and therefore "disposable". However, the real purpose of Ballot Measure 13 is yet another attempt to create a velvety smooth caramel coated medication to SAVE OUR CHILDREN from the SONS AND DAUGHTERS OF SODOM, that ARMY OF SATAN and the CAY AGENDA that is about to enslave the little ones of Oregon and convert them into UNSPEAKABLE

The "traditional" American family has always been largely a fiction and it is, in any case, a train that has already left the station. Legislation against gays or any other minority group in America or in Oregon is not going to fix anything. It causes division, wastes time and money and takes away the focus from the real problems, plans for which people like the OCA have none. It is wool gathering of the most dangerous and insidious sort which can only lead to endless factionalism, infighting and legal waste.




