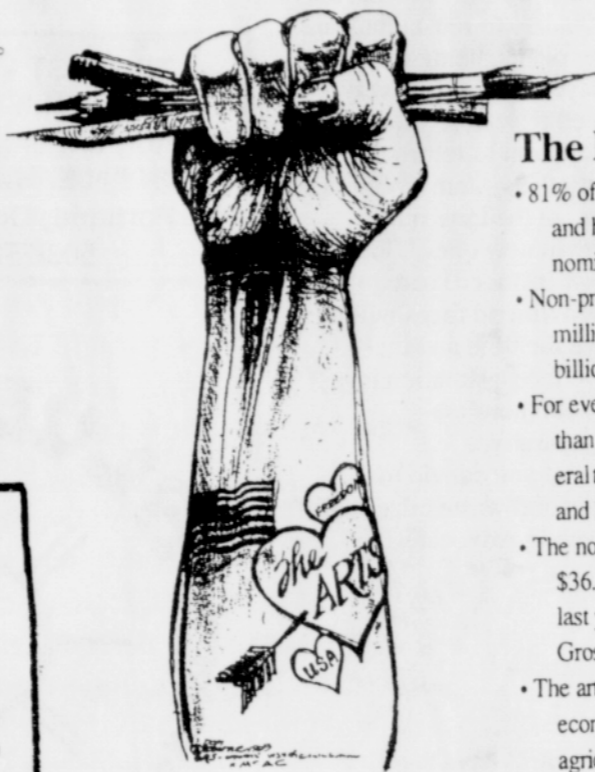

The Facts...

- 81% of Americans believe that "the arts and humanities contribute to the economic health and well-being of society."
- Non-profit arts in the USA supports 1.3 million workers, which generates \$3.4 billion in federal income tax.
- For every \$1 allocated to the NEA, more than \$19 are returned in the form of federal taxes, and more than \$11 in state and local revenues.
- The non-profit arts industry contributed \$36.8 billion to the national economy last year, accounting for 6% of the Gross National Product.
- The arts comprise 6% of the American economy, making them larger than agriculture, construction or 60% of the retail industry.
- Nearly 1% of the jobs workforce came from the non-profit arts industry.

A Revue of American Folklore and Folk Music

The show will consist of live music and narrative from the rich traditions of American folklore: songs and stories, fiddle tunes and jump-rope rhymes, proverbs and ballads, dance steps and tall tales, lullabies and bad jokes.

Performances will be held in the historic Netel Grange Hall, founded in 1910 and currently in the process of restoration. Proceeds will benefit the restoration project as well as The Healing Circle, a group which provides programs for the prevention and treatment of child sexual abuse and domestic violence.

Performance dates are April 28-30, May 5-7 & 12-14; Fridays and Saturdays at 8pm, Sundays at 2pm.

Netel Grange is located 3.9 miles south of Miles Crossing on Lewis and Clark Road, next door to Logan Road Chapel.
