

**Cannon Beach Arts Association offers Artist Grant**


The Cannon Beach Arts Association is offering a \$3,000 grant for original work in any media. The recipient must be a part of the Cannon Beach community, producing or actively exhibiting or performing within the city, or document short-term residence for the duration of the proposed project. The grant amount, \$1500 of which is funded by the City of Cannon Beach, may be awarded in part or in total to those who qualify.

Since the purpose of the grant is to promote the excellence of Cannon Beach artists as well as to encourage art audiences, the artist would be expected to return to the community, by means of temporary exhibit, performance, community education, or as otherwise specified, a portion of the funded project as defined in the proposal.

The 1998 recipient, Peter Lindsey, who has written an anecdotal history of Cannon Beach (portions of which have been published in this newspaper), filled local halls when he read from his work. 1999 recipient Grant Wood is producing a book about the pigments he is creating from local materials. The book, called "The Colors of Cannon Beach", along with works by local artists utilizing his pigments, will be displayed in the Cannon Beach Gallery during September 2000.

Applications for the grant, which are due by August 31st, 2000, are available at the Cannon Beach Gallery, 1064 S. Hemlock in Cannon Beach. Hours are 9:30 am to 4 pm., closed on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.
