

BLAME IT ON THE STARS



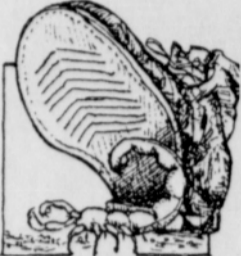

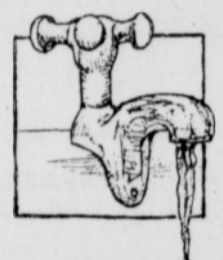

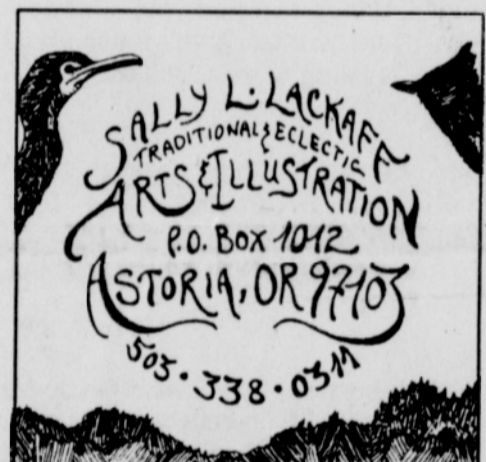
