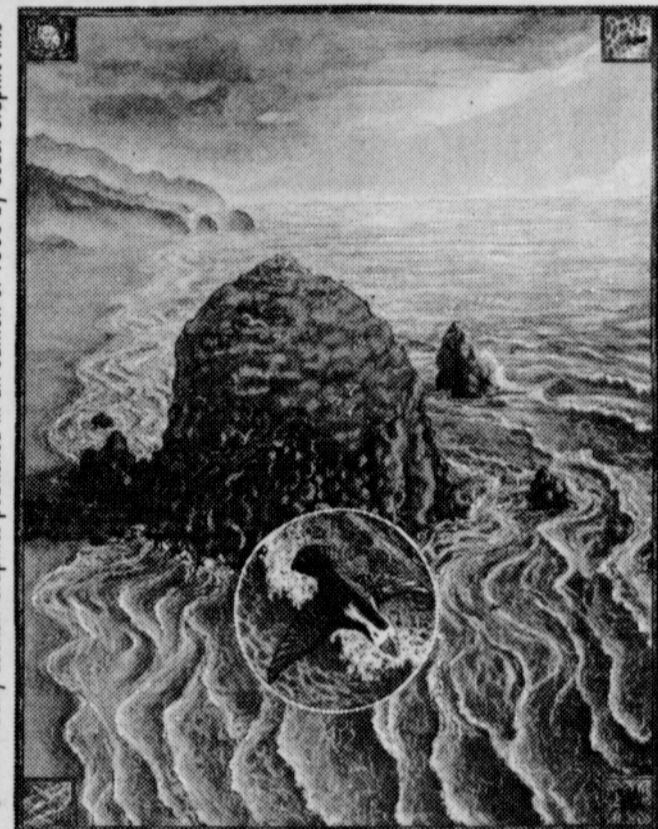

Llama Spit

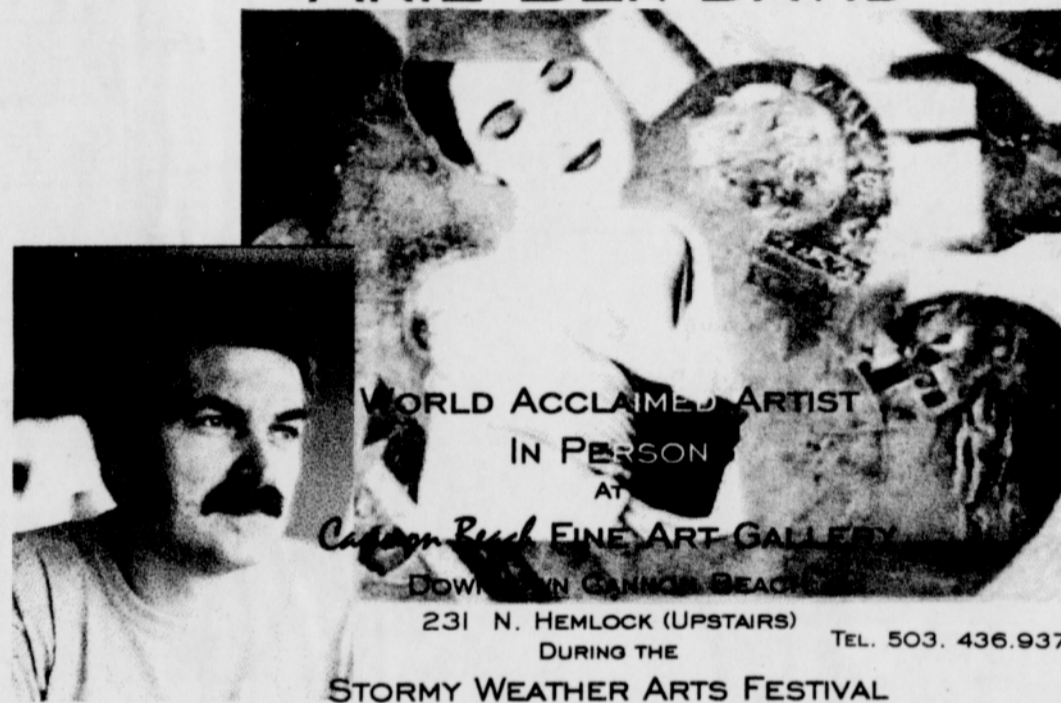
