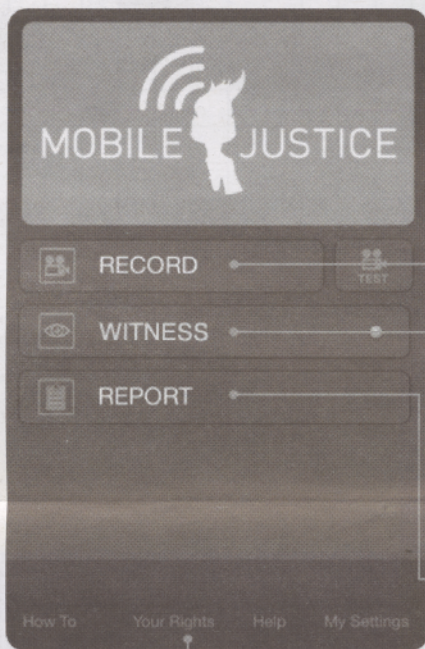


You have the right to film police in Oregon. We made an app to help.



The app has three main functions:
RECORD, WITNESS and REPORT.

The RECORD function initiates your phone's camera. When you are finished recording, the app prompts an incident report that you can fill out with any pertinent information regarding the police interaction you witnessed. This video file and/or report are sent immediately to the American Civil Liberties Union.

The WITNESS function turns on your phone's GPS and will alert you if any other Mobile Justice users have started to film a police interaction in your vicinity.

The REPORT function prompts the incident report even if you didn't film the police interaction.

Mobile Justice also contains Know Your Rights information regarding your rights when you are stopped by police, and your rights to film police.
