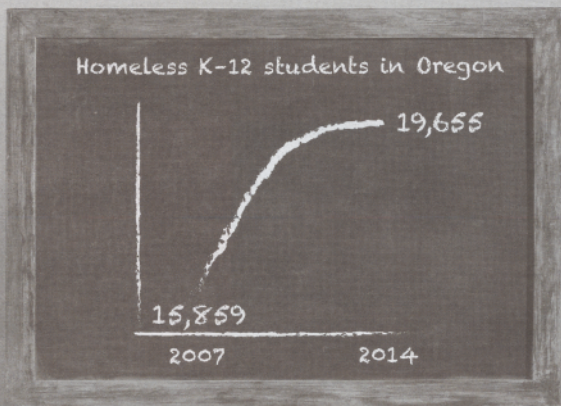


Every child needs a safe and stable home.
