With legalized marijuana on the books, Oregon lawmakers now consider a landmark bill that would help people expunge some past convictions

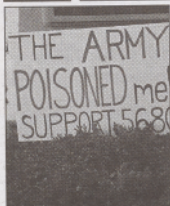
