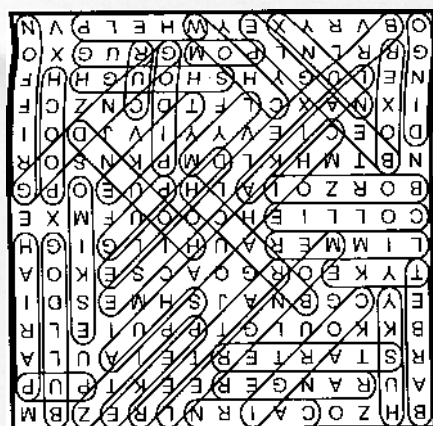
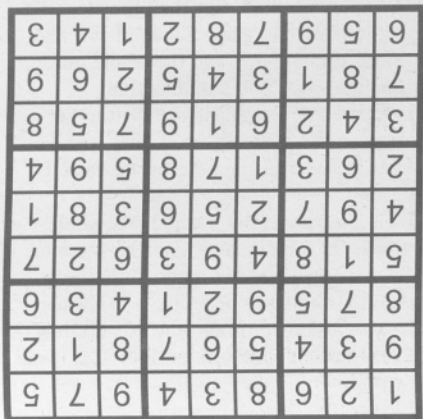
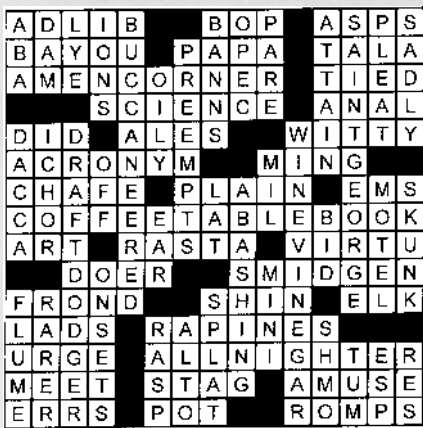

'Sleeping Rough' spotlights vendor prose, poetry

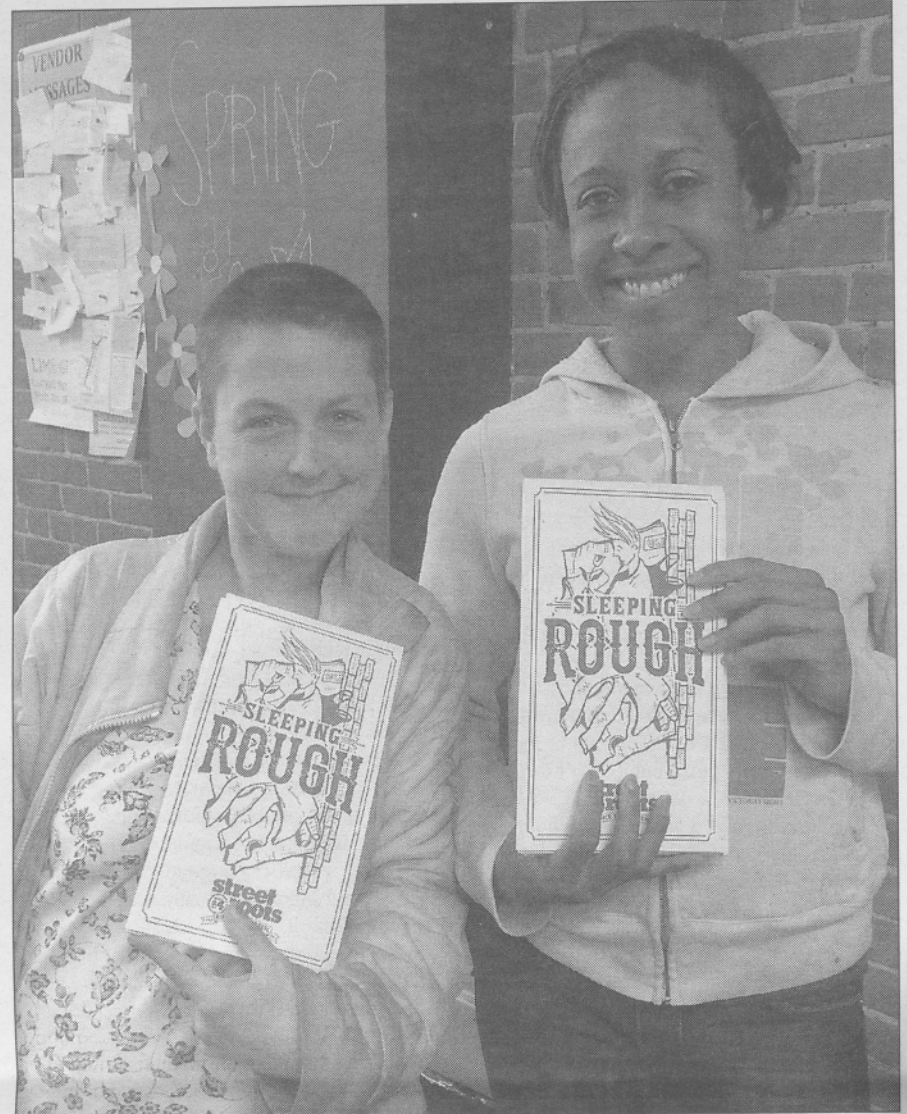

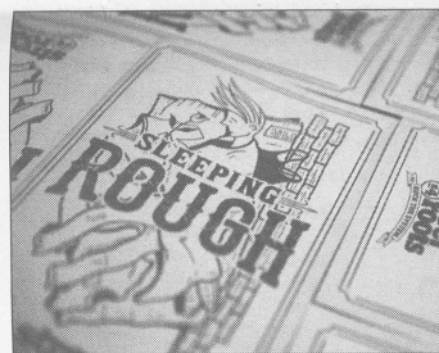
Two answers in our County Commissioner questionnaire (Street Roots April 22-28) were published incorrectly.
