Our Healthy Plate Project helps folks access fresh produce by using barter tickets at farmers markets around Portland. Over \$10,500 was spent by community members in 744 visits to Portland Farmer's Markets this year alone. This goes to show that when the choice is made available, people will buy healthy food.
