Poverty wages and unsafe working conditions worldwide have sparked a labor movement unlike any other, and it's the topic of Annelise Orleck's new book

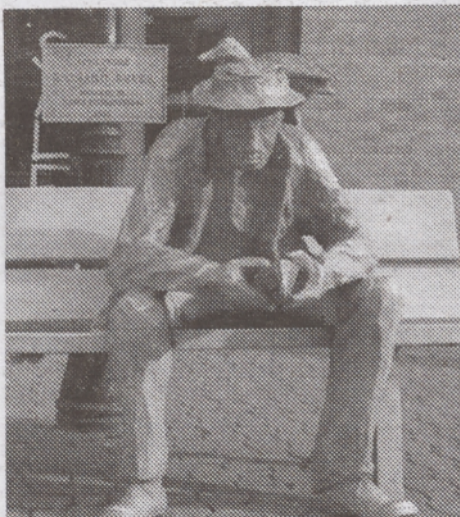
