QUITE A SENSATION

The International Disputes of the United States.

A PREDICTION FROM ALASKA

There is a possibility of boundary differences with Great Britain regarding a part of Alaska-Tahiti Island and the head of Lynn Canal.

TACOMA, January 15.—The Alaskan News, published at Juneau City, makes the sensational prediction that Alaska Inlet and the head of Lynn Canal will become famous the world over as affording grounds for a fierce international dispute between England and the United States and a cause for arbitration by the European powers to determine which country shall hold possession of it according to the provisions of the Russian treaty and the subsequent treaty purchase of Alaska by the United States. The News says:

"Each nation holds fast to a different construction of the Russian treaty, England maintaining that the boundary line does not follow up and around the deep inlets and bays as held by the United States, but follows the general coast line ten marine leagues in the interior from salt water. Great Britain sees a flaw in the treaty, and with her usual aggressiveness will endeavor to wrest from the government at Washington the harbors and inlets about Juneau, so that a British export will not be barred from the Yukon country and the undeveloped Northwestern territory. The good resulting to the commerce of England's provinces by reason of a seaport is too important to be overlooked by England's aggressive foreign policy. Will Uncle Sam under Graham's foreign policy lose valuable possessions in Southeastern Alaska? Since Japan is coming to the front as a commercial power England has her tentacles upon Alaska, and she has a seaport for her navy and commerce-laden ships."

FOR A CENTRAL BODY.

Reform Organizations of San Francisco to Unite.

SAN FRANCISCO, January 15.—The reform bodies of the city have almost completed their arrangements for the organization of a central body Friday afternoon. The committees of the Municipal League and the Civic Federation will to-morrow night draw up a plan and constitution for the central body. The committees of the two main meetings to-day organized, and will be reported at Friday's meeting. The plan of organization is to have a central body, which will act as a clearing-house. All

the body best calculated to handle them. It is the intention to make this arrangement permanent. After municipal business has been attended to the body will meet to work for the advancement of the organizations represented in it. At present there are two central bodies—the Municipal League and the Civic Federation. The name for the new body will be decided upon next Friday. A letter including the resolutions adopted Tuesday night was written to Congressman Maguire at Washington. He is requested to urge upon both the President and Congress the necessity of action in the matter. The committee says that unless the Court Commissioners and District Attorney do their duty the people will resort to stronger methods than resolutions or appeals.

The committee appointed at the meeting Tuesday night to request Police Commissioner Gunst to resign performed its delicate task to-day, and met with a chilly reception. Mr. Gunst refused to recognize them until they had presented their authority in writing. He was informed that a letter which had been handed him was authority, and if he would read it, the committee awaited his pleasure. Mr. Gunst refused to read the paper, and said:

"I consider a piece of imposition and an insult. I have no reply to make."

May be a Stumbling Block.

WASHINGTON, January 15.—The first effect of the discovery by the treasury officials that Spain pays an export bounty on sugar, and that therefore Spanish sugar is liable like European beet sugar to an additional tax of one-tenth of 1 cent per pound, was the cause of much apprehension lest it should prevent the consummation of the agreement which United States Minister Taylor has almost completed with the Spanish government looking to the restoration of American exports to the minimum tariff schedule. But it is believed here this fear is not well founded. As explained by Mr. Taylor, the Spanish bounty is said to be on sugar produced in the Spanish possessions and imported to the United States and is absolutely inconsequential, amounting to but \$1.707 during the last year.

Sugar Bounty Repealed.

WASHINGTON, January 15.—The entire Louisiana delegation in Congress appeared before the House Appropriation Committee to-day to urge that some provisions be made for the relief of immediate losses suffered by the sugar producers and planters of that State, caused by the repeal bill of the bounty provided for in the McKinley tariff bill. They claimed the difference between bounty and duty should be paid to the producers, as fully half of it was earned before the late tariff became a law. About \$6,000,000, it is estimated, will be required to make payment on production up to the time the new tariff went into effect.

The Cup Challenger.

GLASGOW, January 15.—Shipbuilders Henderson were to-day ordered to proceed with the construction of Dunraven's new yacht. It is to be finished by May. The work is to be concluded with the strictest secrecy.

Sale of California Public Lands.

WASHINGTON, January 15.—The House Public Lands Committee has decided to report favorably a bill granting to California 5 per cent of the proceeds of the sale of public lands.

THE LEGISLATURES.

Origin.

The House was unable to do anything at all about the bill to-day, having got itself into deep water parliamentarily, and got out of the same by laying the question on the table and adjourning.

The selection of George T. Myers as temporary Speaker of the House was approved by him as a graceful compliment to his popularity. During his brief administration he made a noble and impartial presiding officer.

Senator Hudson has a bill regulating the manufacture and sale of oleomargarine. The dairymen have a meeting at Salem Wednesday, and he will submit his bill to them. It contemplates in effect with a few amendments the Massachusetts law, which has stood the test of the United States Supreme Court and has been sustained.

Senator Gowen, who represents a district 250 miles long and is much interested in irrigation, says the bill emanating from the Irrigation Committee is being reported from the Ways and Means Committee two weeks before the close of the session. It will probably cause some awkwardness about subsequent insertion of amounts appropriated, but the president of having the bill passed before public attention will be of great value.

The spirit of the star-eyed goddess permeates the galleries in the House, and everything saving of economy is applauded to the echo. The great demonstration of Monday was on the defeat of the customary resolution calling for five copies of newspaper or three copies of the House Record. An effort to compromise on three copies was swept off its feet in a wave of economy, and the galleries tumultuously testified to their approval. Finally on motion of Paxton the whole subject was indefinitely postponed.

As was expected, an effort will be made to supplant the State Board of Horticulture by a State Horticultural Inspector. This was the scheme favored by Representative Upton last session, and whose advocates succeeded in defeating the bill of the practical fruitmen. The bill, however, is now being introduced by Representative Upton, and it is expected that it will pass. The bill provides for the appointment of a horticultural inspector, who will be in charge of the State Board of Horticulture. Any person shipping fruit must affix to each box, package or parcel containing the same a distinct mark, showing the name of the producer and shipper of the same. The inspector will have authority to inspect any fruit or plants infested with any injurious insects or disease, or who shall sell or offer for sale such fruit or trees, or who shall neglect to attach a distinct mark thereto, and who shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100, and to imprisonment for not more than 30 days.

The fourth session of the Washington State Legislature convened Monday at noon, and after the organization of both the Upper and Lower House an adjournment was taken until Tuesday. With the exception of three or four members all the legislators were present, and the lobbies of both Houses were crowded with spectators. Morrison of King was elected Speaker of the House, and the other more important officers were chosen in both branches. All were elected in a formal manner, the contests having been decided in caucus early in the morning. The petty officers and clerks are to be decided upon in the House.

The most important feature of the first day was the adopting of a resolution in the House to reduce the salaries of employees 10 per cent and the adoption of a concurrent resolution by the Senate to provide for the appointment of a committee to investigate the affairs of the Land Commissioners. The latter says that it appears from the report of the Board of Land Commissioners that the State has been defrauded to the extent of \$1,000,000. The committee will be composed of five members, to consist of three members from the House and two from the Senate, which shall at once proceed to examine into and report upon the method of transacting business and operation of the respective offices of the Board of Land Commissioners, the Commissioner of Public Lands and the several county Boards of Tide-land Appraisers, and shall be the special duty of said committee to report to the Legislature as to whether the methods of conducting the business in each of the several offices referred to are economical or not; whether the service of the officers referred to has been efficient and satisfactory or not; whether or not any or all of the several offices should be consolidated, abolished or continued. The committee is given authority to call for persons and papers and to administer oaths. The resolution was adopted unanimously.

There has been much talk during the past several months about the Land Commission, and the fact that the resolution to investigate the matter was one of the first acts of the Senate is being discussed freely. The investigation promises to be one of the most absorbing features of the session, and will be watched with interest by all people of the State.

JAPAN AND CHINA.

Third Japanese Army Embarking for the Shang Tung Coast.

LONDON, January 15.—The Times correspondent in Kobe telegraphs under date of January 8: It is reported that several transports have left Ujima with a portion of the third Japanese army. It is expected that the embarking will be completed the 11th. The Emperor gave an audience to the commanding officers the 6th. The transports will rendezvous near Chemulpo, and are expected to land troops at two places on the Shang Tung coast south of Wei Hai Wei.

The Times correspondent in Hong Kong says that Admiral Fremantle has gone with the fleet to Japan, presumably to follow the Japanese movements.

Title to North Brownville Land.

WASHINGTON, January 11.—The Senate to-day passed the House bill to settle title to lands in North Brownville, Lincoln county, Oregon.

DEFENSE OF CHINA

Manchurian Princes Take the Matter in Their Own Hands.

LI HUNG CHANG'S INFLUENCE.

They Find This to be Necessary in Order to Prevent the Intrigue of Chinese Officials—Chinese Struggles to Become Sovereigns. Lost to All Human Feeling.

LONDON, January 15.—The Times has this dispatch from its Tien Tien correspondent:

The Manchurian Princes have taken the defense of the country into their own hands. The intrigues of the Chinese officials aim to thwart them; hence a conflict that paralyzes the executive power. Li Hung Chang, though relieved of all functions except that of Governor of the province, still indirectly influences the officials. Chinese arriving from Manchuria report that the country between the rivers Yalu and Liao Ho is desolate. No houses are standing. The timber has been burned, and towns and villages, erstwhile populous, are without a soul. Only the skeletons of the Chinese, of frozen corpses are seen. Food and fuel cannot be got. The wounded suffer terribly. The movements of troops on both sides are hindered by the exhaustion of the supplies, which the country people at first scattered through fear. The stragglers from the Chinese army, who have taken refuge in the hills and forests, have become savages, lost to all human feeling.

THE ARMIES IN THE FIELD.

LONDON, January 15.—The Central News correspondent in Tokio quotes a dispatch, dated at Hai Chang yesterday, from Lieutenant-General Katsura, who represents that one portion of General Sun's army left Yung Kow January 8 for Kaiping and another portion marched in the direction of Hai Chang. The enemy's main force retreated January 10 to Ku Ho River. The Japanese cavalry now occupy the Chinese positions. Daring his dispatch at Kaiping, yesterday General Nogi reports that his scouts say General Fing with some 10,000 Chinese is in the vicinity of Tachio. Other Japanese commanders report a large force of Chinese in the vicinity of Yung Kow and Lao Ya Tien.

General Nich, while escaping in a carriage January 10, passed within fifty meters of the Japanese, who killed his horse, wounded him and nearly made him a prisoner.

The Chinese peace envoy, Chang Tsin Hoon, arrived in Shanghai this evening with a suite of fifty-six. The Cantonese oppose his going to Japan, and declare that his placards that he will disgrace China.

DECLARATION FROM RUSSIA.

ST. PETERSBURG, January 15.—The Novoye Vremya to-day in a leader on the Eastern war:

"If the friendly and peaceful representations of Russia's diplomacy be not considered, she will be compelled to support her claims on Corea with force of arms."

THE YONG HAK INSURRECTION.

LONDON, January 15.—The Tokio correspondent of the Central News says:

In a dispatch from Fusan Captain Tani reports that an insurrection in Yung Kow has been suppressed. A captured spy declared that the insurgents would prove the sincerity of their principal chiefs and forty others. The Captain and the Korean authorities examined the Tong Hak prisoners, who declared that division had occurred among them, when the Japanese sailors and Korean soldiers attacked them and completely terrified them.

THAT ATHLETIC MATCH.

The English Are Determined, and Will Bring It Off If Possible.

LONDON, January 15.—The permanent Secretary of the London Athletic Club was shown a dispatch detailing the reply of Chairman Williams of the Athletic Committee of the New York Athletic Club to the interview with Holman, Honorary Secretary of the London Athletic Club. Mr. Parker said:

"I cannot at present speak officially, but I am sure that of the dates given, September 12 and September 21, the committee would prefer September 12, for the more important reason that the members are obliged to go back to their studies at the opening of the term in October. Twelve letters which I have received to-day have confirmed our previous belief that the meeting in May would be impossible. But something has to be given in order to arrange for the international meeting, and the London Club's autumn meeting, September 28, therefore, will probably be abandoned. The London Athletic Club will send a team from within the limits of its own membership, and will make the best fight possible. The greatest interest is taken in the match among members of the club, and the opinion is that too long a season has elapsed without an international contest."

West Coast for Their Families.

DUNOON, Feb., January 15.—The prospects for a speedy settlement of the miners' strike are apparently very good. The men are willing to work on short time if their comrades, who were recently discharged, are taken back. They say they will make this concession in order to keep the families of the idle miners from starving. Mr. Elliot, the general manager for Lewis, Bell & Yates, the owners of the mines in which the strike is on, has gone to Dunoon to lay the proposition from the men before the firm. He is expected back to-morrow, and upon the reply he will bring depends the immediate outcome of the strike. The strikers say they are willing to make an amicable compromise that will give all of them at least enough to provide bread for their families.

Co-operation Again a Failure.

SPOKANE, January 15.—The Morning Times has ceased publication for lack of support. The Times was started in the interest of Representative Wilson in his Senate race. An attempt was made to run the paper partly on the co-operative plan, the printers being guaranteed \$2.75 a night, the regular union scale being \$4.50. They received but a small fraction of the wages guaranteed, and refused to work longer.

Keels Extradition Proceedings.

WASHINGTON, January 14.—Responding to a resolution of the Senate, the President has sent to that body a copy of the extradition proceedings of General Escala, late Vice-President of Salvador, and other rogues who were granted asylum on board the Bennington. Much of the correspondence is of a technical legal character.

THEY'RE AFTER GUNST.

San Francisco Again Say Everything Bad of Him.

SAN FRANCISCO, January 15.—Two monster mass meetings were held in this city this afternoon to protest against the appointment of M. A. Gunst as Police Commissioner; to denounce local political corruption and to protest against District Attorney Knight for not causing the arrest of C. P. Huntington. The first two subjects came in for the greater attention from the various speakers.

Dr. Elbert Dille addressed the big audience that crowded Old Fellows' Hall to the doors, filling gallery and floor, until there was not a seat left. Held at the instance of the law and order league, it was a significant and enthusiastic demonstration, marked by fiery speeches and followed to the close by the hearty accord of a gathering wholly in earnest.

Dr. Dille compared the government of a Republic to a pyramid, saying:

"Only two things can reach the top—the eagle and the lizard—and in city affairs it is the reptile that gets there, leaving the stony trail behind. All the gamblers and all the vicious are saying: 'We've found our Moses. We've got San Francisco and a fence around it, and our Moses to lead us into it.'"

Dr. C. O. Brown's message to ex-Governor Markham was read. It was:

"With loose rule, drug rule, corruption rule and the indifference of good citizens this has become a government of the worst, by the worst and for the worst. You have done this to please the liquor men and the gamblers. They have put their brand on you, and you are their man. The mark you have put on yourself is indelible. There is an immortality of infamy. From this hour Governor Markham stands convicted as a man who seeks the approval of the drooping of his head, and the vilest of men who have thrown a mantle of shame over the closing hours of a wrecked administration."

One leading sentiment ran through all the speeches: "We want a new charter. When a new law was called to the platform he said:

"Good will come of the Gunst appointment. Out of it will come a new charter, and we will see to it that the whole miserable Police Commission is wiped out of existence. We do not want a Police Commission in fraternity with the gamblers, saloons and brothels. No man has any business on the Police Commission who has any connection with gambling and pool-sitting. This appointment says to the gamblers, 'Boys, you can go on about your business, and I as a Police Commissioner will wink my eye at that side.'"

BILL COOK CAPTURED.

The Notorious Oklahoma Outlaw Run to Earth in New Mexico.

SANTEE, Feb., January 15.—United States Marshal Hall to-day received a dispatch from Sheriff C. C. Perry, of Chavez county, who yesterday captured Bill Cook, the notorious outlaw of Oklahoma, stating that the prisoner had been safely landed in jail at Roswell this forenoon. The outlaw's capture was effected at an isolated cattle ranch a few miles southeast of Old Fort Sumner. Perry and two deputies were in search of horse thieves east of Fort Sumner yesterday, when Sheriff Perry met and recognized Cook at the first glance. Cook, who is a fast runner and a man of nerve, and although he had two six-shooters about his waist, his hand went up at the command of the Sheriff.

Handcuffs were put on his wrists, and he was mounted and strapped on his back, while the Sheriff and his other deputy rode behind him. Thus the trip to Roswell was made, a distance of sixty miles. Marshal Hall expects to hear from the United States District Attorney of Oklahoma, Arkansas and Texas, to whom he wired, announcing Cook's capture. It is said that with the State, express and railroad companies there are rewards amounting to \$15,000 for Cook's capture. In an interview with the captured bandit at Roswell he acknowledged himself as Bill Cook, and said that when captured he was on his way to Mexico and meant to go to the highway. He said:

"The officers here will take me back where I am known, and I don't give me hell like the other fellows have for I have not committed half the crimes that are charged to me. I have done all my work on the open highway. I have killed any one who has ever robbed a poor man unless it was of a horse or food that I was compelled to have when dodging the officers.
