

Oats:—Receipts for the week, 24,065 cents, almost wholly from California points. The recent active demand for oats for government contract purposes induced interior holders to make extra efforts to secure transportation for oats. This contract has now been filled, leaving the demand confined to local business only, and this demand is at present exceedingly limited, as many horses have been turned out and local consumption is diminished thereby. In all markets there is a disposition shown to await the termination of the strike before attempting to do any great volume of business. Buyers are disposed to rest on their oars and await developments, in saying this we have no particular reference to strike conditions, but to uncertainty in minds of speculators as to future of market. We quote red oats of fair quality, \$1.05 to \$1.07 $\frac{1}{2}$ (per cental) No. 1, \$1.07 $\frac{1}{2}$ to \$1.12; Choice \$1.12 $\frac{1}{2}$ to \$1.17 $\frac{1}{2}$. Feed blacks,
