THE ROMANCE OF WORDS

"WHIST."

MANY persons, in seeking the derivation of the name of the popular card game, have come to the conclusion that it originated in any one of the popular ejaculations calling for silence or attention—the Latin "s," the German "hist," or the Scotch "whist." This explanation sounds logical, but there are others who as stoutly maintain that the name was derived from the fact that trump "sweep" or "whisk" the board, a contention which is supported by a study of at least three of the languages which enter into the ground-work of English.
 Thus, in German, we find "wisch," meaning a "mop." In Danish, the equivalent of the verb "to wipe" is "viske" and in Scotch it is "wiska"—all of which bear a striking resemblance to the English "whist." Another form of the same word may be found in the term "whisk broom," meaning a broom which whisks or flecks or wipes particles of dust from clothing and the like.
 "Whist," therefore, instead of signifying silence or attention, takes its name from the use of the trump-suit and naturally dates back to the days when the "no trumps" declaration was unknown.

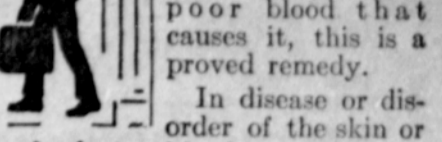
