U. of O., Eugene, Feb. 12, (Special)—The U. of O. basketball team holds first place in both the Pacific Coast and Northwest conferences, taking top position after defeating O. A. C. at Corvallis and W. S. C. at Eugene. The University of Washington was at the head of the percentage column until a defeat by Idaho at Seattle on Monday night.

Oregon has suffered only one conference defeat this season. Coach Reinhart's men lost to Washington, but in all fairness to the Oregonians it must be said the team was not in the best shape when the game was played. Hobson, weak from the effects of a vaccination which "took" violently, went into the game after several days in the infirmary. He played bravely but ineffectively. Against W. S. C., Monday night Hobson was back in form, scoring 12 of Oregon's 30 points.

For the first time this season the Oregon team is now lined up with five regulars in Pacific Coast conference games. Hobson and Gowans, forwards; Okerberg, center, and Gillenwaters and Westergren, guards; will face the Idaho quintet Friday. Jost, a substitute center and guard, appears to be the strongest second string man on the Oregon squad. He gave a good account of himself against Washington.

While Coach Reinhart made no advance statements predicting what his team would do in the conference race, Oregon fans are satisfied with results. Oregon may not win the championship, but the team is going to make a hard fight for first honors.

Veterans of the World War who have not submitted applications for their bonus are urged by Lt. Col. C. F. Andrews, city recruiting officer, U. S. A., to do so at once. The importance of applying at the earliest possible date is urged upon the veterans by Col. Andrews who states: The War department is daily receiving cases in which veterans who thought themselves in the best of health have died or have been killed by accident without having submitted their applications for adjusted compensation. Their widows and children, many of them in needy circumstances, receive in such cases cash to the amount of the adjusted credit, an amount equal to approximately one third only of what he would have received in one payment in cash had the veteran made application prior to death. For instance, should a veteran who served overseas for a period entitling him to the maximum amount of adjusted service credit of \$625, die without filing his application, his widow, children, or other dependent within the restricted class, will receive that amount only in ten quarterly installments while if he filed his application prior to his death the widow, children, or dependent will receive approximately \$1580 in one payment in cash. Cash payments under the Act become due on March 1, 1925, and payment will be delayed unless the veteran applies a sufficient time in advance of that date to enable the War Department to properly pass on applications and transmit it to the Veterans Bureau.

Veterans may obtain application blanks, have their finger prints taken, and be rendered other assistance in completing their applications at any Army Recruiting Station in Oregon or Washington.
