TILLAMOOK ASSOCIATION LEADS COW TESTING WORK

Advantages of long-continued cow testing appear in the latest report of the Oregon cow testing associations by N. C. Jamison, extension dairyman for the state college extension service.

Associations reporting were Tillamook with 1574 cows, Melowest No. 1 with 677, Melowest No. 2 with 650, Coquille Valley 807, Columbia with 582, and Central Oregon with 510; total 4800.

The high honor purebred cow of all associations was Rose Mary, Jersey, owned by Millard Martin of the Melowest No. 2 association. She gave 1475 pounds of milk with 92.8 pounds of fat.

Ten unprofitable cows were disposed of for the good of the business within the month.

WORLD HONORS GREY FATHER OF SAFETY

Thousand of highway travelers in all parts of the world today hail Thomas H. Grey, Southern Pacific pensioner retired after nearly forty-one years service, as "Father of Highway Safety."

In 1884, while working in the railroad's car repair shops at San Francisco, Grey designed the now familiar cross arm railroad crossing sign.

Within a few months the new type of crossing sign was in general use throughout the United States, and at the end of ten years its use had spread to European countries and to Japan.

Grey, retired and living quietly at Burlingame, California, says that he has the satisfaction of knowing it has saved many lives and prevented thousands of accidents.

MEMBERS OF FRATERNAL ORDER TO VISIT COAST
