For those planning to certify potatoes it is very necessary and desirable that any diseased plants be rogued out as soon as they appear, reports G. R. Hyslop, in charge of the certification at the college. A number of the potato diseases are spread by aphids. Because of this, any diseased or doubtful plants are a menace as soon as they show up.
