In the creation of the MID-PACIFIC COAST EMPIRE in Oregon Mother Nature played the role of the engineer par excellent. Rogue river flows westward through the heart of Southwestern Oregon and has an estimated potential horsepower of upwards of 300,000 horsepower; while the Deschutes, the Applegate, the Illinois, the Chetco, the Elk and the Sixes rivers each contribute their quota toward the great quantity of potentially cheap power within the region.

And further, Mother Nature did not stop there, but with her unerring engineering wisdom She provided a natural deep water harbor on the shore of the region, strategically situated for economical improvement as the tidewater outlet through which the products of this great empire may flow to the marts of the world by means of cheap water transportation.

The Port Orford Chamber of Commerce is now engaged in the preparation of its case for presentation to the Board of Engineers, Washington, for the improvement of the Port Orford harbor to make it an all year round harbor.

Requires Limited Protection from South and Southwest Storms of Winter.

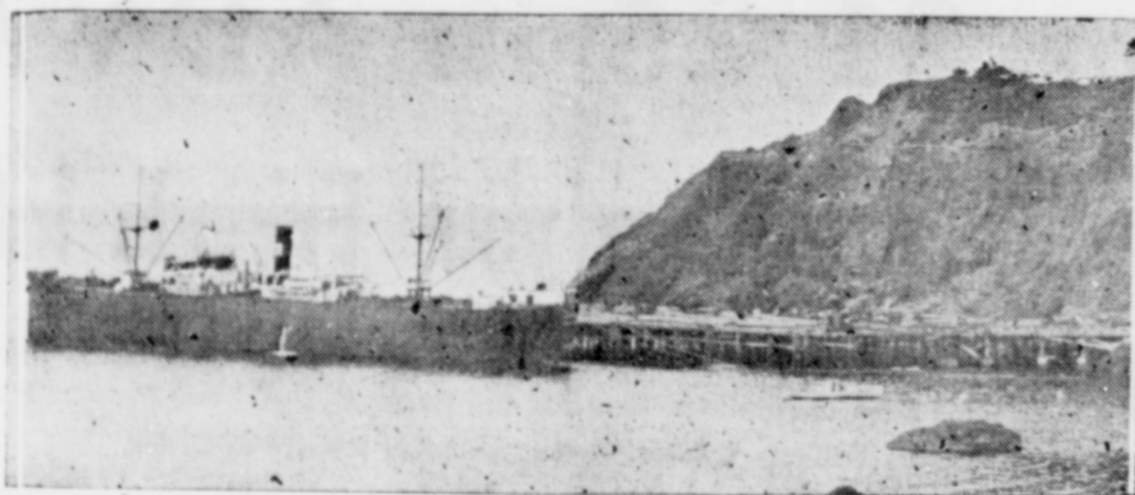
