Gratitude for spiritual growth and progress was the keynote as Christian Scientists from many countries attended the annual meeting of The Mother Church, The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Mass., Monday afternoon.

Named President of The Mother Church for the coming year was Ralph E. Wagers of Boston and Chicago.

A native of Michigan, Mr. Wagers is a well-known Christian Science teacher, practitioner, and editor.

Stressing the vital importance of a deeper, more practical application of the spiritual teachings of the Bible Mr. Wagers told the meeting, "Let us go beyond mere formal religious devoutness and achieve the spiritual mindedness that enables us to minister to the people's spiritual needs as Jesus did."
