Poison Oak Control Told

Poison-oak plants can be controlled by the proper application of herbicides during the next two months, according to Lou Oester, county extension agent.

While complete eradication cannot be expected in one year, a follow-up spray the second year should give reasonable control of this pest, says Oester.

Satisfactory chemicals that are likely to be available are amitrole and the hormone brush killer, 2,4,5-T. These chemicals are absorbed through the foliage and kill the roots of the plant. It is best to spray early in the morning when the air is calm so the chemical will not drift to other susceptible plants.

Plants can also be removed by mechanical means but there is danger of contact with this method. The poisonous substance can be carried on clothing and tools. All roots should be removed to prevent regrowth.

A bulletin that contains further information on the control of poison-oak and poison-ivy is available at the extension office.
