American Sportsmen Fare Better Than Europeans

Following are excerpts taken from a letter received from Alfred D. Straughan, of Miami, Fla., a world wide traveler and sportsman: "Got back Saturday night after many thousands of miles travel. Found the British Isles very interesting, but the weather anything but inviting. The first two or three weeks it rained almost every day and was raw and cold.

"Going through the Irish Free State, the streams all looked promising and there were very few fishermen. The carrier on the coach said the fishing was excellent.

"In Scotland we watched the fishing boats come in just about every day; watched them unload their catches, and then watched them auctioned off to the highest bidder. We have never tasted such good fish as we enjoyed up on the northeast coast of Scotland. The halibut was as firm and tasty as the white meat of chicken. The waters are icy cold and the fish excellent. Fishing there is a dangerous life and hardly a day went by without some boat on the rocks or being caught in a tremendous rough sea.

"Being green, we wondered why the cannons were fired in the night, but found that it meant a boat in
