"Beachcomber's Daze", the theme of the flower show to take place during the Port Orford July 4th celebration, has listed the following schedule.

Entry will be afternoon and evening July 2 and July 3 from 8 to 10 a.m. Judging will be at 11 a.m. with ribbon awards. Exhibits will be released Sunday, July 5, at 3 p.m. The show is being held at the Port Orford Grade School.

Designs: (No artificial flowers or foliage with or without accessories).

Class 1: "Good Mornin'". A coffee table design (fresh material); B—"Welcome", entry or hall table (fresh material); C—"Peace", mantle arrangement (fresh or dry materials); D—"Little Jewels", miniature (no measurements over 5 inches); E—"Western Winds", using driftwood or weathered wood.

Class 2: A, "Beachcomber's Daze"—celebration theme; B, "Cruising Down Through Curry County"—Curry County Fair theme.

Class 3: Potted plants, A—Begonias; B—Cactus and Succulents; C—Geraniums; D—Others, potted plants will be divided as entry warrants.

Class 4: Specimens: A—Branches (1 branch) B—Other specimens (1 stem or 1 stalk) will be divided as entry warrants; Unlimited entry (class 3 and 4) as long as different.

Class 5, Junior Division: same as class 1, 3, 4.
