

### Driftwood Show Set For Fourth

In conjunction with flower and art shows, a driftwood show has also been set for the annual July 4th Celebration in Port Orford, with the flower show committee, headed by Mrs. Clara Erwin, sponsoring it.

The top exhibit in the three class unlimited entry show will be selected by Miss Beachcomber and receive her purple ribbon.

Held at the local grade school, entries will be received Thursday evening, July 2, and from 8 to 10 a.m. Friday, July 3. Exhibits will be released at 3 p.m. July 3.

Ribbon awards will be made and artificial flowers and foliage may be used, as well as accessories of any kind.

Class I—Beachcomber's Paradise. Designs using driftwood.

Class II—Jewels of the Sea. Miniature driftwood designs, no measurement over five inches.

Class III—Wealth of the Tides. Other use of driftwood. This class will be divided by the judges.

### July Fourth Flower Show Events Noted

"Beachcomber's Daze", the theme of the flower show to take place during the Port Orford July 4th celebration, has listed the following schedule.

Entry will be afternoon and evening July 2 and July 3 from 8 to 10 a.m. Judging will be at 11 a.m. with ribbon awards. Exhibits will be released Sunday, July 5, at 3 p.m. The show is being held at the Port Orford Grade School.

Designs: (No artificial flowers or foliage with or without accessories).

Class 1: "Good Morning", A coffee table design (fresh material); B—"Welcome", entry or hall table (fresh material); C—"Peace", mantle arrangement (fresh or dry materials); D—"Little Jewels", miniature (no measurements over 5 inches); E—"Western Winds", using driftwood or weathered wood.

Class 2: A, "Beachcomber's Daze"—celebration theme; B, "Cruising Down Through Curry County"—Curry County Fair theme.

Class 3: Potted plants, A—Begonias; B—Cactus and Succulents; C—Geraniums; D—Others, potted plants will be divided as entry warrants.

Class 4: Specimens: A—Branches (1 branch) B—Other specimens (1 stem or 1 stalk) will be divided as entry warrants; Unlimited entry (class 3 and 4) as long as different.

Class 5, Junior Division: same as class 1, 3, 4.

Mrs. R. K. Erwin is chairman. Mrs. Val Townley is in charge of the arrangements; Mrs. Albert Moore, specimens; Mrs. Dale Peck, entry.

#### TIPS FOR HOMEMAKERS

##### Warm Weather Means Extra Care for Meat

Whether you are picnic or camping, bound it's wise to give some thought to temperatures when planning for your meat. The sun can raise the temperatures of the meat in a picnic basket or the camping larder in the trunk of your car and the number of microorganisms will begin to increase at a rapid rate, after temperatures begin to rise.

These microorganisms plus the action of the natural enzymes in fresh meat can result in what is commonly termed "spoiled" meat, that causes food poisoning. Be sure to check the label to note whether or not canned meat also needs refrigeration. "Fully cooked" does not mean the meat has been processed to the point that it has been sterilized but only that it has been heated to at least 148 degrees.

Once out of refrigeration meat should be cooked immediately and cooking means thorough heating, not just singed on either side.

Poultry needs extra attention in the summer months and should be kept cold until ready for the pan. Pork should always be cooked adequately to guard against trichinosis.
