What about cold water detergents? Should they be used for all the wash? This depends on what's in your wash basket. Some items benefit by cold water washing. Colors stay brighter and there is less shrinkage

of knitted items. Cold water laundering can provide a longer useful life to many items such as elasticized garments. With cold water, there is less wrinkling or setting of stains. But in any case, stains should be

pre-treated with cold water. Hot water is best for many items. It helps control bacteria and is important in removing heavy soil, grease and body oils. Remember, cold water detergent can be used in hot or warm water as well as cold.
