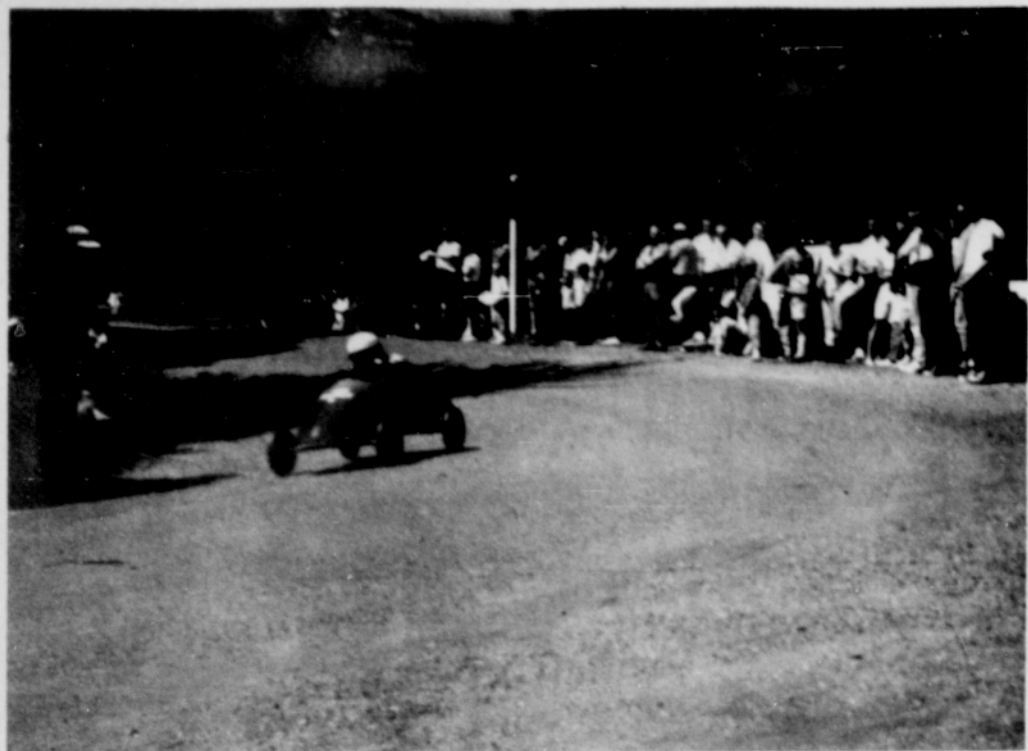

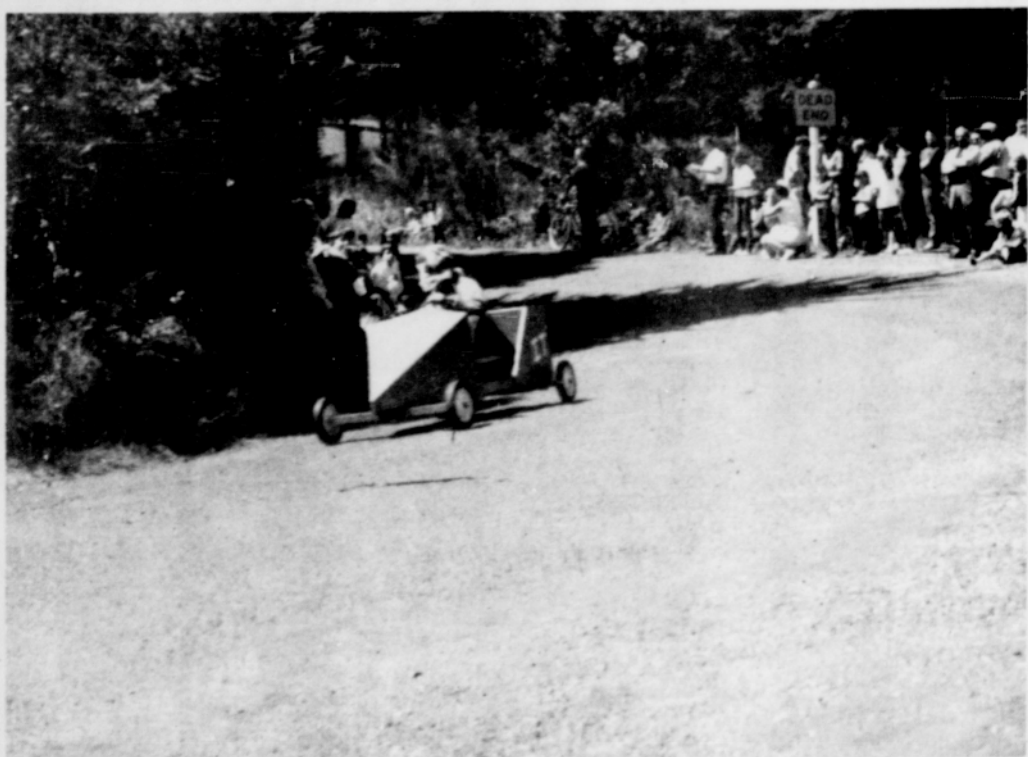
the CUBMOBILE DERBY

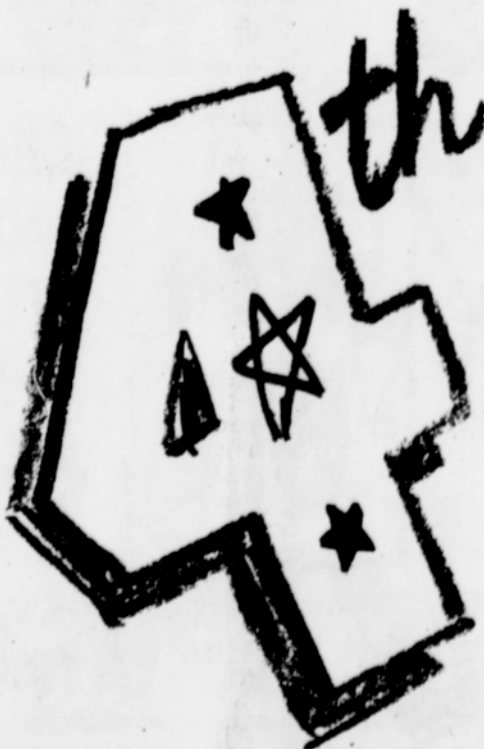


SEVENTY-SECONDS flat, took second place and \$2 for Jimmie Zastera in his "Red Arrow" cubmobile.

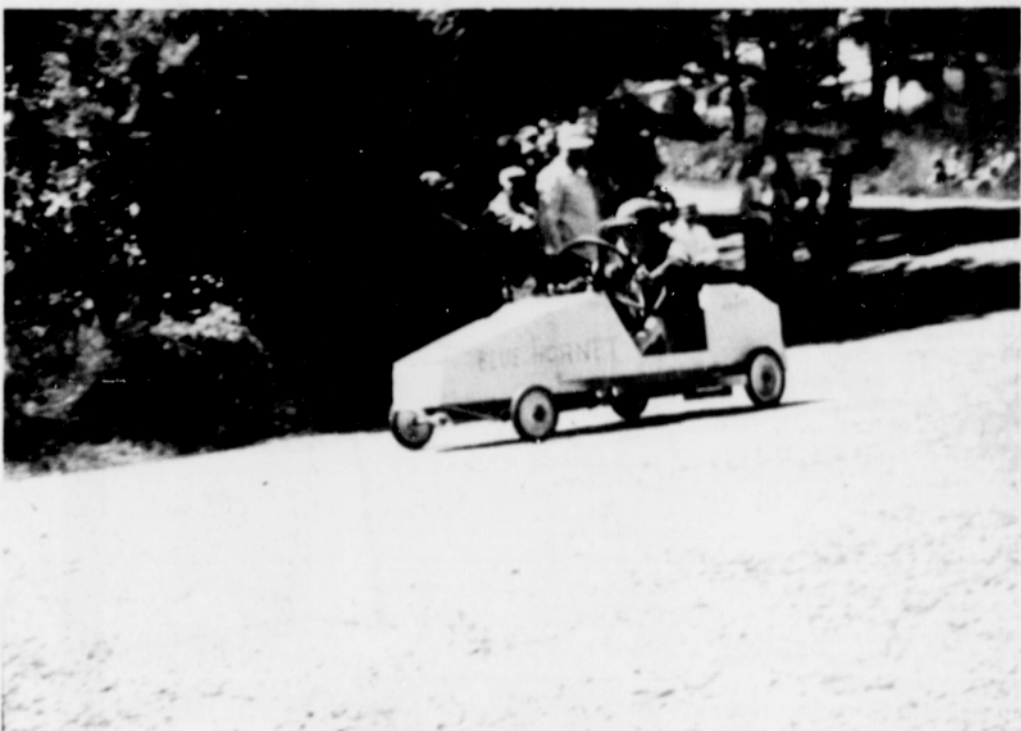


RANDY FOSTER, driving "It", placed third, as crowd watches Port Orford's first soap box race. His time was 78 seconds, earning him \$1.
