## As The Deer Hunting Season Nears

It is along about this time that most deer hunters grow nervous in anticipation of the forthcoming opening of that popular season, which occurs Sept. 30 - as most of you already know.

Somewhat we are inclined to believe that the old bucks themselves become a bit nervous along about this time. Nature, in some mysterious manner, serves to protect the creatures of the wild by endowing them with an uncanny instinct that is beyond the understanding of mere man. Yet, such an instinct - or sixth sense - is largely responsible to the deer herds' status in numbers, in many of their natural habitats in the states in which they continue to abound today.

## BUCKS TAKE OFF

Any veteran hunter can recall dozens of incidents during the past where bucks could be glimpsed daily up to within a day or so of the opening of the hunting season. They would be seen not only in the hunting country, but in such places as farm yard orchards and nearby fields, and even in vegetable gardens adjacent to rural homes.

But, strange to relate, came opening day and no buck was in evidence. It had simply taken off for parts unknown to the baffled hunter.

While hunting grouse or other upland birds - prior to the opening of deer season - hunters have chanced across numerous bucks which showed no fear of them... to the point that the grouse hunter was almost forced to kick them out of his path.

The hunter was certain that he really "had it made" as far as bagging his buck on opening day was concerned. Brimming with anticipation, he could scarcely contain himself until that day occurred. There was no doubt in the hunter's mind that the first day of the open season would prove to be his day of fulfillment. For was he not one blest with good fortune to have blundered upon the haunts of the mighty bucks while gunning for grouse? But what happens? Yes, you've already guessed it... not a single buck in sight. Unbelievable? Yet it happens to the best of hunters in fairly regular fashion - season after season.

## ADVICE TO HUNTERS

It may prove to be entirely wasted effort on the part of this scribe to warn hunters about the careless handling of firearms and the firing at unidentifiable objects while in quest of deer, but here goes. However, if such a warning issued should serve to save one life or prevent one serious accident, we would feel thankful and rewarded for having issued such a warning. But anyway, we keep on seeking our share toward the prevention of accidental shootings.
