Measles Shots Can Stop Spread

The usual winter-spring increase in measles cases can be averted if vaccine is given immediately to most remaining susceptible children from one through eight years old, the Oregon State Board of Health said today.

Estimating that thousands of Oregon children still have not been immunized against measles, the Board's Immunization Program reminded parents that measles cases begin to increase in the fall and reach a peak in spring.

Dr. Edward Press, Oregon State Health Officer, urged immediate immunization of all children who haven't been immunized previously or haven't had the disease itself.

"Measles today is truly the disease that shouldn't be," Dr. Press said. "It is completely unnecessary because one shot of vaccine provides immunity against a disease that can kill, deafen, blind, and cause mental retardation."

Dr. Press said the Immunization Program in the past 18 months has distributed more than 100,000 doses of measles vaccine to private physicians and local health departments, but despite this, and despite the independent efforts of many doctors, measles cases continue to occur throughout the state.

Even with widespread use of measles vaccine by private physicians and health departments, Oregon this year through Nov. 18, had 1,693 cases of measles reported—only 445 less than the 2,138 reported in the same period of 1966 and many cases are not reported. However, both figures are far below the median of 5,622 cases for 1962-66—before measles vaccine was used extensively in the state.

Nationally, recorded cases of measles during the first nine months of 1967 were less than 13% of the average level in years before measles vaccine was used. About 200 cases were reported each week in September of 1967, compared with a pre-vaccine weekly average of about 1,000.
