Notice is hereby given that an election will be held in School District No. 2CJ of Curry-Coos County, State of Oregon, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on June 1st, 1970, at Langlois Primary School and Port Orford Elementary School in said school district, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said district the question of increasing the tax levy for the fiscal year 1970-1971 over the amount limited by section 11, article XI, of the Constitution of Oregon.

The reasons for increasing such levy are: In order to certify to the County Assessor the amount required by O.R.S. 310.350 and 310.360 and the necessary expense of operating the schools exceeds the tax base of School District 2CJ.

The amount of tax, in excess of the constitutional limitation, proposed to be levied for said fiscal year is \$206,134.00, which, expressed as a rate of levy, is estimated at \$6.76 per thousand of true cash value of taxable property within the district.

ROUDDOR RAMBLINGS

The comet that was visible during the latter days of March and early April just at the break of dawn as it streaked across the star-studded sky was well worth watching. The comet itself consisted of a rather large ball-shaped object, gleaming brightly up there in the vault of the heavens, with its short sparkling tail seeming to weave a pathway through the glittering stars. This comet was named for its discoverer, J.C. Bennett, of South Africa.

However, despite its brilliant performance, it sadly lacked the dazzling performance and the thrilling display as viewed during those long past years, when Haley's Comet hewed its blazing path during many nights, up there millions of miles beyond the Western Hemisphere. Its tail was one of tremendous length, brilliance and truly beautiful.

GLORY IN THE SKIES

The Haley Comet was, indeed, a most glorious, glamorous, fantastic and awesome sight to behold. Mere words are sadly lacking in attempting to describe it, for the simple reason that it was a sight of a nature that defies description.

We feel that we have been fortunate to the extent of being afforded the rare opportunity of viewing both the Haley and Bennett comets during their fiery flights across the skies. As a youngster, we spent several evenings back there in those now far distant days of the past, as in wide-eyes wonderment, and no doubt tinged with fear, as completely spellbound we watched the blazing comet—a great ball of condensed glowing light, followed by its long tail that appeared to consist of millions of brilliant, star-like objects, blaze its way across those vast stretches of outer space up there that lie millions of miles above this earth.

Incidentally, the Brookings Pilot, in its April 2 edition, reproduced three outstanding pictures taken of the Comet. They are the finest of their kind that we have ever had the opportunity and the pleasure of viewing.

SOUTH COAST Anglin's

Legal sized trout up to 12 inches have been released into the Pistol, Chetco and Winchuck Rivers and Hunter Creek to supplement the natural populations of sea run cutthroat currently in the streams.

Cutthroat should also be available in the lower holes of the Elk, Sixes and Rogue Rivers with worms, crawfish tails or small wobblers usually the most productive lures.
