ALL POINTS BULLETIN

This taxpayers' alert is addressed to all Curry County voters who are tax conscious and concerned.

I respectfully suggest you scan the County budget for the coming fiscal year July 1, 1970, to July 1, 1971, which will be published today, May 21, 1970. This new budget is only slightly under \$5,000,000.00, up nearly 1 million over this year.

Time and space permit only this one comparison, which I herewith submit:

District Attorney: Budget last year \$15,000.00, this year \$24,000.00, coming year \$46,000.00. One District Attorney, salary \$17,000.00, of which \$4,254.00 is County money. One full time "non-support investigator," (his brother Bud) County money \$8,124.00. New Deputy D. A. Again, County money, \$12,000.00. Total salary for D. A. \$37,124.00. Plus full time legal secretary, plus extra help.

From the Oregon blue book, and telephone calls to the three District Attorneys of comparison counties as outlined below, we quote:

Hood River County—Population 14,000, True Cash Value \$103,000,000. One D. A., with No assistant—Salary \$14,000.

Baker County—Population 16,000, True Cash Value \$201,000,000. One D. A., No assistant, salary—\$14,000.

Tillamook County—Population 17,000, True Cash Value \$142,000,000. One D. A., No assistant, salary \$19,000.

Curry County—Population 13,000, less than the other three, and static or declining over the past decade, True Cash Value \$115,000,000 and again less than the other three, with THREE District Attorneys costing you as stated, \$37,124.00.

I am taking the liberty of speaking for the people of Curry county. I respectfully ask the Curry County Board of Commissioners and the other three members of the budget committee: What study or method was used to arrive at District Attorney's budget figure, and how can it be justified? Once again, respectfully I ask, that your reply be made public in this newspaper. Again, may I remind you, none of these "observations" are to be construed as personal; only principle is involved.

the high lakes in the Cascades, Paulina, and Siskiyou mountains. In most waters the season will extend through October 31.

Streams along the coast are reported to be in excellent shape and good trout fishing results can be expected. Anglers are reminded that the minimum length limit in these waters is 8 inches. This important regulation provides protection to downstream migrant salmon and steelhead, most of which will range from 5 to 7 inches.

Cutthroat trout have been stocked in many coastal streams for the opening weekend. With wild populations of cutts also in the streams, anglers should make some fine catches. Good bets include the Lewis and Clark, Youngs River, Elk Creek, Rock Creek (Nehalem tributary), Beaver Creek, Clatskanie, Miami, Tillamook, Nehalem, Trask, Kilchis, Necanicum, Nestucca, Ya-chats, Siletz, and Alsea. The Wilson and Salmon rivers should also produce for the opening.

Good-sized cutthroats will also be stocked in many south coast streams. Some top choices include the Chetco, Pistol, Hunters Creek, Elk River, Milliloma, the upper forks of the Coquille and the Siuslaw. Among anglers in the know,

the Siuslaw is ranked as one of the best cutthroat trout streams in the state.

In the Rogue headwaters anglers will find quite a bit of snow in the Blue and Seven Lakes basins but most lakes are free of ice. Fishermen willing to pack in over the snow should make some fine catches. Lakes are also free of ice in the Siskiyou such as Bolan, Tannen, and Babyfoot.

Major trout streams in the upper Rogue will be stocked with rainbows for the May 23 opening. The spring thaw is late and increased water flows may make fishing more difficult than in past years. Nevertheless, good catches can be expected. Anglers should also make some nice catches of cutthroats in some of the smaller headwater streams.
