

To Get Questionnaires

About 20,000 hunters - approximately five percent of the total - will be asked to assist the Game Commission in the next two months with the annual survey to determine how many big game animals, upland birds, and waterfowl were taken during the 1972 hunting seasons.

This group, selected at random from the total of around 375,000 licensed hunters, is being asked to provide individual reports on success or failure during the past year. A separate questionnaire will

be used this year to accurately determine the take by archers. Random sampling of license records now under way is expected to be complete in late December. Hunters selected should receive their individual questionnaires by early January.

John McKean, state game director, asked recipients to answer all questions as accurately as possible and to record success as well as failure. The questionnaire should then be returned to the Game Commission.

Information provided by hunters is used to compute the total take of game for the year, which includes deer, elk, bear, upland game birds by species, and all species of waterfowl.

Statisticians advise that the total harvest figure obtained from this random sample of hunters is very accurate. For elk, game birds and waterfowl the accuracy is said to be close to the one percent margin of error. For deer, accuracy is said to be plus or minus one

percent.

The survey, including the results, is expected to be complete by March or early April.

Keep Records

Norman O. Nilsen, the State Labor Commissioner, has issued a reminder to working Oregonians that they keep accurate records of all work performed in order to insure that they receive the correct amount of pay.

The records should include where the work was performed, the type of work performed, the number of hours of work and the rate of pay. Nilsen said such records are admissible as evidence if a dispute should arise.

The Labor Commissioner said that persons who have questions about wage problems should contact the Wage and Hour Division of the Oregon Bureau of Labor at the Bureau's offices in Portland, Eugene, Pendleton, Salem and Medford.
