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# Bucs Take Bandon; Tournament On Tap

The Pacific Pirates made it three for three (all Sunset League teams) when they defeated the Bandon Tigers last Friday night, 46-40. The Bucs had previously beaten Brookings and Myrtle Point. Guard Randy McCune led the Pirates with 22 counters, and teammate Bruce Colven grabbed 19 rebounders. Bob Scheidemantel was also in the double figures column for Pacific with 10 counters.

Pacific took a 12-point margin into the lockerroom at the half, 30-18. At the end of three quarters the Pirate lead was down to 36-30, and in the final stanza both teams scored 10 points.

Take More Shots  
Bandon actually took 14 more shots than the Pirates but converted just two more field goals. At the charity stripe the visitors connected on 12 of 16 while Bandon had but two for five. Pacific coach Doug Orton called the contest "a real barn-burner." He felt his team had a good game on the defensive side, but "they didn't execute very well on offense." Orton also commented that his team's poor shooting hurt them. Orton is in his third year as head coach at Pacific. He praised the sparky McCune for his play, and singled out Colven for his rebounding efforts. The coach also had good words for transfer Bob Scheidemantel. Orton called the six foot forward "scrappy," and said he was a welcome addition to the team. Scheidemantel hit for 10 points, and collected six rebounds.

## Tournament Is Friday, Saturday

Pacific will host the annual tournament Friday and Saturday, December 14-15. Gold Beach and Powers will square off in the opening contest at 7 p.m. Pacific will meet Bandon at 8:45. Losers of the contests will play for third place at 7 p.m. Saturday. Winners will meet at 8:45 p.m. for the championship playoff. A first place team trophy will be awarded.
