SHERIFF'S NOTICE OF SALE OF CURRY COUNTY REAL PROPERTY ACQUIRED BY FORECLOSURE OF DELINQUENT TAX LIENS.

WHEREAS, Curry County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, has heretofore acquired each of the hereinafter described pieces of real property by way of foreclosure of delinquent tax liens; and

WHEREAS, the period of redemption for each of said pieces of real property has expired and each of said pieces of real property has been deeded by the Sheriff and Tax Collector of Curry County to said County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Curry County made an order on the 16th day of January, 1974, wherein said Board directed the Sheriff of Curry County, Oregon, to sell each of said pieces of real property, and wherein said Board fixed the minimum price for which each of said pieces of real property should be sold; and

WHEREAS, a certified copy of said order has been delivered to the Sheriff of Curry County, Oregon;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALLEN H. BOICE, Sheriff and Tax Collector of Curry County, Oregon, do hereby give notice that commencing at the hour of 10 o'clock A.M., on the 25th day of February, 1974, I shall offer for sale the hereinafter described real property on the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

1. That Curry County shall not guarantee or warrant any title whatsoever nor guarantee or warrant that any of the properties sold are free of any sort of encumbrances or other liens; nor shall Curry County guarantee or warrant any boundary liens; and all sales shall be at the sole risk of the buyer in all ways and regards. It being understood that Curry County is only offering for sale whatever title, interest or ownership Curry County may actually have, and not otherwise. If it is necessary to clear any clouds or claims on the title or interest in and to said property at any time hereafter it shall be at the sole obligation and expense of the buyer.

Win Pair Of Games

It was a good weekend for the Pacific high Pirates as they defeated North Douglas here Friday night, 76-43, and Glendale there Saturday night, 67-49, to put them 3-1 in the win column of the second round of Big Fir league play.

And it was also a big weekend for Randy McCune and Bruce Colvin. Friday night McCune tallied 26 and Colvin 21 points, with Colvin snagging 21 off the board. Saturday night McCune racked up 34 counters, while Colvin tallied 18, along with a whopping 26 rebounds.

In the North Douglas contest Pacific took an early command of the game and outscored the visiting Warriors 24-14 in the first period, and took a 41-23 lead into the locker room at halftime.

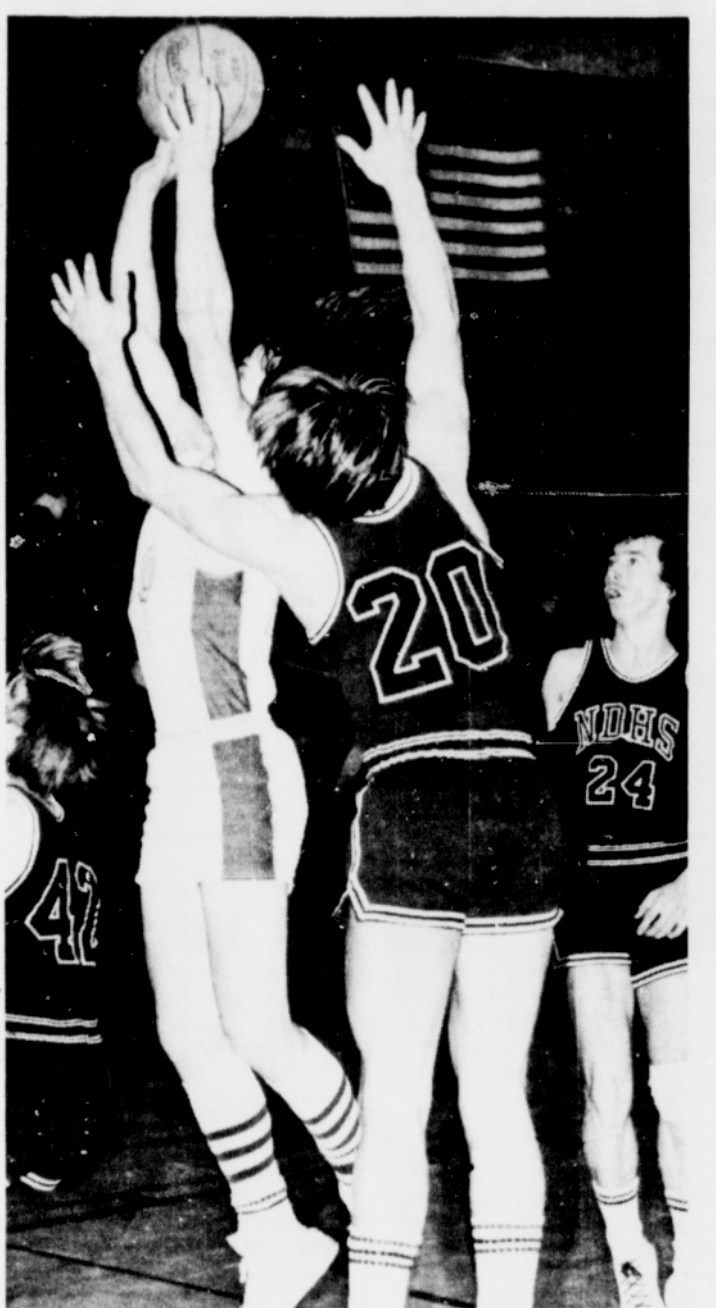
In the third stanza, Pacific topped North Douglas 16-12, and doubled the Warriors 19-8 in the final period to end the game at 76-43.

The Pirate JV's also tapped the young Warriors to the tune of 60-40.

At Glendale, Pacific brought their second half record to three wins and one loss, to put them one game behind league-leading Elkton.

Speaking of McCune and Colvin, Pirate coach Doug Orton said, "They couldn't handle them. They're having a good year. Colvin has scored 90 points in the last four games and McCune has tallied 108. Bruce has also picked up 83

rebounds. Pacific meets Riddle here on Friday, February 22, and travels to Yoncalla on Saturday.
