POAC will retain 20 percent commission on all pieces sold. Artwork may be picked up after the show or by arrangement.



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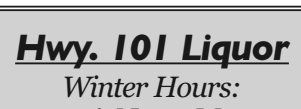
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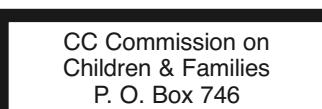
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
