group planning to sue the state, because ODFW hasn't done what the statute mandates them to do.

Critical of hatchery policies ...

Krieger was also critical of the way the Native Fish Conservation Plan and hatchery policies are addressing the issue of salmon recovery, declaring, "with our hatchery practices, the way we are restricting ourselves, we will never in a hundred million years recover salmon to what I call prime numbers, fishable numbers, both sport and commercial - it isn't going to happen."

Noting that the last time ODFW built a new hatchery was 1964 (the Elk River

Hatchery was built with funds from commercial fisheries), Krieger said he would like to see some new hatcheries built. "Most of the hatcheries are worn out. They're antiques. They don't have good water systems; some of them have disease problems." He also feels ODFW should have been striving to make hatchery fish and wild fish compatible: "What makes wild salmon and hatchery fish different? It isn't the fish that

made themselves different; it was hatchery management that caused the changes in those fish. Recognizing what that is and changing it ... could be incorporated into some new hatcheries."

Three Coastal Caucus members are collecting information on the total hatchery releases in the last 10 years in Oregon, Idaho, Washington, and California, in order to compare Oregon's policies and results with those of the other states. Krieger plans to sit down with them after they have collected and analyzed the information, and "statutorily write salmon management."

supervisors pickup with overheads and hand tools.

All engines are started and warmed up daily, all small engines which are chainsaws, light high pressure pumps, volume pump, and any other vehicle mounted small engines are started daily.

When not on call the fire crew practices hose lays, work and discusses hand trailing tools, attends lectures on fire ground safety and fire behavior, and does maintenance on the station such as painting or other deemed tasks that help keep the station looking

Fourmile station's first response of this fire season was a small gorse fire up Elk River that also was mutual aided with Sixes and Port Orford Rural.
