Opening the show is well known Port Orford musician Steve Montana.

He has played at numerous venues along the southern Oregon Coast including Bandon Dunes, The Surf Shack and the Paradise Café.

He will open the show on Sunday night with an hour of wonderful and classic rock tunes from the 1950's, along with a few cowboy swing and jazzy numbers.

Steve will be joined on drums by Ted Owens. Audiences enjoy Montana's finger style and more complex chord structures and progressions. But don't let that fool you, he will rock out some, come on out and tear up the dance floor.

Some of Steve Montana's songs will pay homage to Buddy Holly and Ritchie Valens. It was a little over 50 years ago that they both died in a small plane crash on February 3, 1959, just outside of Clear Lake, Iowa. They and J.C. Richardson (The Big Bopper) had played a concert in Clear Lake at the Surf Ballroom and were trying to save some time getting to their next show.

Tickets for the Sunday night's show are \$6 in advance and available at the Downtown Fun Zone and \$7 the night of the performance. Doors open at 6:30 p.m.
