Port Orford Police Officer Randy Dresser and Bill Potter, right, stand over the suspect who was “tasered.” During the encounter, which was witnessed by approximately 20 onlookers, Dresser showed great restraint and professionalism while responding to a confused, yet potentially dangerous, individual who was in great distress.

Editor's note: I watched. I shot the pictures - many more than this - many showing the subject's face. I commend both Officer Dresser and Bill Potter for their conduct during the encounter. I chose not to print any of the pictures showing the subject's face because he was non-violent, although non-cooperative.

August 15
Police received a report of bicycles being stolen from a local business. Report taken, case is under investigation.

August 18
Officers received a report of a burglary in progress. Upon arrival, a possibly intoxicated subject had broken into a private residence, and had created a scuffle with the resident. The subject was unruly, and had to be subdued with an electronic control device. Subject arrested for Burglary, Criminal Mischief, and Disorderly conduct, transported to the Curry County Jail and lodged.

ODOT road report

Curry County US 101 (Oregon Coast Highway), MP 282-295, Bethel Creek to Crystal Creek Paving

Nighttime grinding and paving work will continue until late September. Lane closures will be required with nighttime and morning delays up to 15 minutes. Motorists should watch for uneven pavement conditions and intermittent day-time lane closures. Flaggers will provide traffic control. All lanes will be open from Friday afternoon to Sunday evening.

US 101 (Oregon Coast Highway), MP 317, Euchre Creek Bridge (\$4.4 million)

Motorists should watch for intermittent weekday lane closures with traffic controlled by flaggers. Watch for trucks and heavy equipment north of the bridge as excavation work continues on the southbound shoulder.

The Euchre Creek access road (US 101, mile point 317) at the north end of the bridge is closed until October. A detour route will be in place and motorists bound for the community of Ophir should turn onto the County Road 510 access road (US 101, mile point 318.4). Detour signs will be in place prior to the road closure.
