"... all of you, are my good friends," he concluded smoothly

ly as "his friends" around the room burst into laughter.

However Clancy was still unsatisfied, and related an incident where she didn't feel her application for the commission might not have been fairly considered. This led to a call from Auburn to reestablish order.

"I call for order," he said, adding to Clancy, "and will have you ejected if you continue!"

Clancy began to speak again, leading Auburn to say, "I'll admonish you!"

"Well, admonish John (Hewitt) too," sniffed Clancy, her British accent lending emphasis to her displeasure, "he interrupted, too!"

"I'll admonish you," returned Auburn.

At that the pair subsided and the meeting continued. Later the two reconciled, noting that each enjoyed working with the other.

Immediately following, the council voted 4-1 in favor of adding Robertson, who sat with a quiet smile on his face through the entire exchange and vote, to the Planning Commission.

The water report

Finally, Donovan sat up a power-point projector and showed the council, staff and crowd the results of the engineering study concerning the city's water distribution and storage system, which is now losing water at the rate of over 50 percent monthly.

"If you have a low water year, the city is required to initiate water conservation," said Donovan, a series man with glasses and lots of answers, not all of them pleasant.

"That's based on the current water loss," he noted. Donovan reported what all of

the council know already; We have an inadequate water storage system and a water distribution system that is now losing half of every thing we pump through it.

Recommended is a complete replacement of the distribution system: "You may not need to replace 90 percent of the system, but you don't know," said Donovan of this projection.

He also recommended raising the current, 12-foot high dam with a 38-foot earthen dam.

Costs for the two-phase project, which allows for one phase to be funded and completed without hindering the other, will be an estimated \$11,750,000 to replace the distribution system and \$3,829,000 to upgrade the reservoir.

The study included estimates of the city's needs "50 years out," and our region's heavy

storm and runoff activity.

At the conclusion the council thanked Donovan. With the study in hand and the funding applications for the USDA grants now completed, it will be a waiting game to see if any of this hard work and necessary infrastructure improvements will come to fruition.

"In the best possible scenario we might hear about our funding this Fall," noted Auburn.

"I hope so," said Murphy, "And we could start construction on the distribution system in the Spring (of 2011)," said Auburn.

Wagner closed the meeting by thanking his Public Works Crew for "all of their hard work" and great safety record.

The next council session will be held at 3:30 p.m., Thursday, May 6, at the Gilbert Gable Council Chambers.
