Of Farmer Interest

One of the newest developments in the rapidly changing agriculture of Clackamas county is the use of crimson clover and rye grass for temporary pasture, according to County Agent J. J. Inskeep, who states that approximately a thousand acres of this mixture has been planted here this spring.

With adequate rainfall crimson clover rivals rape as a summer pasture, and for fall and spring the clover and Italian rye grass has no equal for local conditions, according to Mr. Inskeep.

Compulsory state-wide prune marketing standards were ruled out for the present time recently by J. D. Mickle, state director of agriculture.

Farmers who grew no wheat during 1937, 1938 or 1939 but expect to grow wheat in 1940 and wish a 1940 wheat allotment should make written application within the near future to their county committees, stating the allotment desired, according to announcement by N. C. Donaldson of Corvallis, state executive officer for the agricultural conservation program in Oregon.
