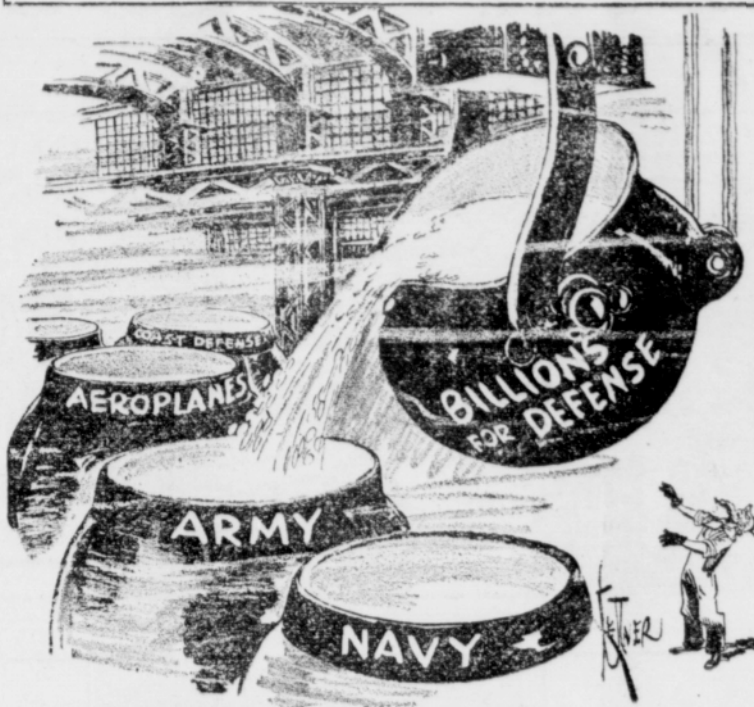

The W. P. A. sewing unit in Gresham, which was formerly a part of the Portland set-up, has been made into a separate Gresham Unit.

There are sixteen people from Gresham and its environs now employed at the Eagles Hall. The project is sponsored by the Oregon State Welfare Commission and co-sponsored by the Gresham Commercial Club.

The Welfare Commission supplies the material for production, the Gresham Chamber of Commerce and Gresham Eagles furnish space, heat, light, and water; the government furnishes the labor. Garments and flat goods are made and turned over to the needy and to charitable institutions.

The Gresham Unit makes approximately 5000 pieces per month, 2500 flat pieces, and 1500 garments. Those wishing to visit this project are welcome to do so at any time.

COWS TEST 100 PER CENT**

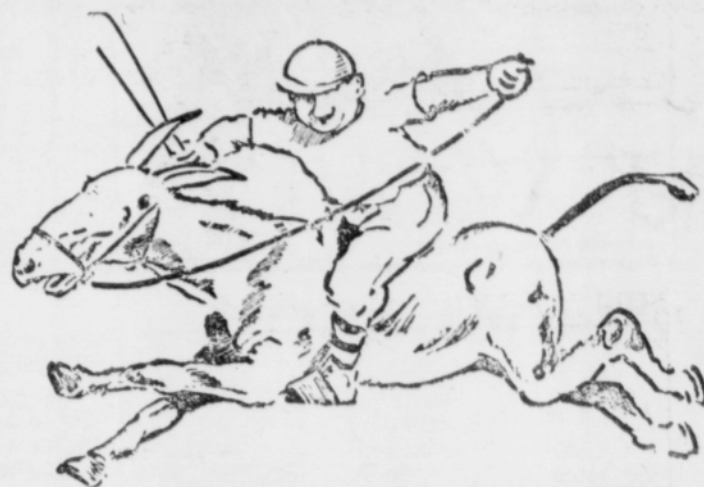
