Pat Bacon left Saturday evening for Baker where she will spend a week with her husband, Curtis Bacon, who is stationed in that city.

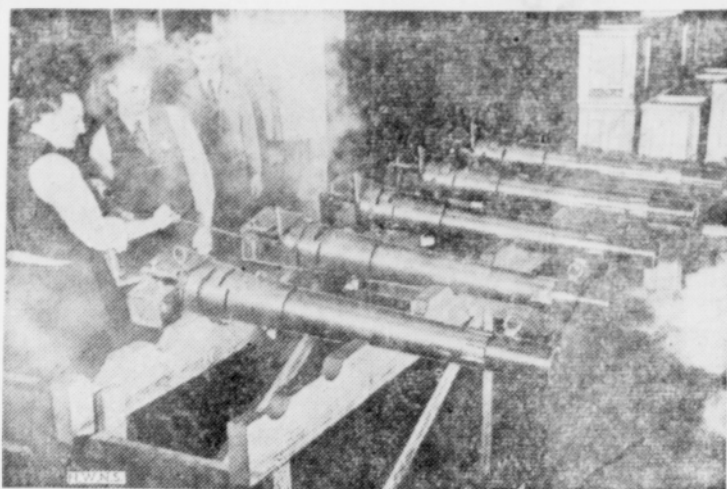

BOOKMOBILE TO START MONDAY, JULY 28

Modernistic and attractive in appearance, carefully planned for efficient work and economy of space, the new Clackamas County Bookmobile will make its initial bow to the public Monday, July 28. Rounds of the county will be made every two weeks until September 1, at which time, with the addition of 93 rural schools to serve, the schedule will become a monthly one.

The new truck has just emerged from the shops of Wentworth and Irwin, Portland, where it has been rebuilt and painted for its specialized use. Steel shelves with a special device for holding books tightly in place will accommodate about 600 books and floor cupboards about 100 more. A special jump seat has been provided for an assistant or for the librarian when accompanied by a driver. An excellent ventilating system with fans has been installed for hot weather operation and a heater for cold-weather use.

The driver's seat turns to face a well-built charging desk equipped with filing drawers and card slots. The top has been raised to give ample head room to patrons selecting books, and the entire truck has been painted a light grey with green interior shelves.

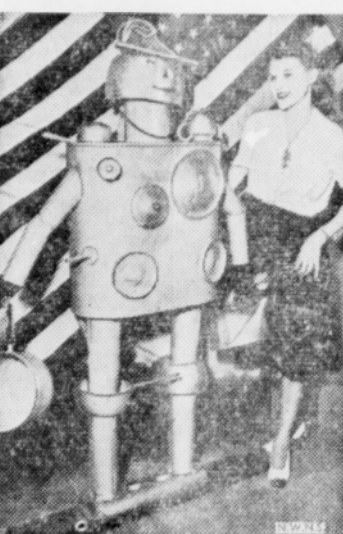
Operating on what is practically a daily schedule, the new bookmobile will carry to the branches and deposit stations, individuals, and school children and their teachers of the county, books it would otherwise be difficult for them to obtain. A small reference collection will be on hand; there will be a bulletin board display, every effort will be made to fill special book requests.

In establishing County-wide service with a bookmobile of its own, Clackamas County is falling in line with a widespread movement constantly becoming more popular in this country.
