

SPORTSMEN'S INFORMATION

While hunters are purchasing more antelope tags this year than has been the case in any year since open seasons on this fleet-footed animal were established, there are still tags available for hunters who desire them, according to announcement by the Oregon State Game Commission.

This year there are two antelope seasons: the first, in that

part of Malheur county south of the Burns-Ontario highway from September 22 to October 5, both dates inclusive. The second antelope season will be held in parts of Lake and Harney counties from September 28 to October 5, both dates inclusive.

The bag limit is one antelope of either sex, and tags cost \$1 each for resident or nonresident hunters. This fee is in addition to the regular hunting license fee.

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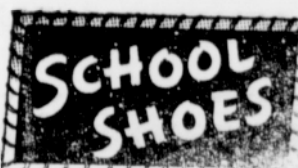
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
