High School Course Offered by Mail

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are offered as well as courses in business, social sciences and art. A student who is world minded, may enroll for world history, civics, economics, and social problems. At the present four English courses are being revised. Miss. Mozelle Hair, head of the correspondence study department states that being added to regular courses, those essential for defense work are being prepared. She is working with Donald M. Emeson, state director of school administration and secondary education, in an effort to have these courses ready by fall. They include arithmetic, mathematics, biology, and physics. State Superintendent Rex Putnam is recommending the courses to high schools and has approved the acceptance of the credits by high school principals, who have final authority on the acceptance of these credits. Some districts, Miss. Hair said, are even paying the fees so that their students may take courses not offered in their own curriculum. State statute now permits school districts to pay such fees.

Firewood Delivery Now Restricted

following order of preference:
1 Consumers who need firewood for any purpose other than heat, domestic hot water or domestic cooking, in the amounts needed, but not beyond that extent necessary to bring their total inventory of all fuels to their annual fuel needs for such purpose.
2 Consumers who need firewood for heat, domestic hot water, or domestic cooking (except consumers who use fuel oil, gas or electricity primarily for such purposes), and whose total fuel on hand is less than one-fourth of their estimated fuel needs, to the extent necessary to bring their total inventory of all fuels to one-fourth of their annual (continued in the next column)

fuel needs for such purpose.

3 Consumers who need firewood for heat, domestic hot water, or domestic cooking (except consumers who use fuel oil, gas or electricity primarily for such purposes), and whose total fuel on hand is more than one-fourth but less than their estimated annual fuel needs, to the extent necessary to bring their total inventory of all fuels to one-half of their annual fuel needs for such purpose.

4 Consumers who need firewood for heat, domestic hot water or domestic cooking (including consumers who use fuel oil primarily for such purposes), and whose total fuel on hand is more than one-half but less than their estimated annual fuel needs, to the extent necessary to bring the total inventory of all fuels to their annual fuel needs for such purposes.

5 Consumers who use gas or electricity primarily for heat, domestic hot water or domestic cooking, to the extent necessary to bring their total inventory of all fuels to their annual fuel needs for such purposes.

If conservation of labor or efficiency of transportation will be served thereby, nothing in this order shall be deemed to prohibit any delivery to a consumer of a full load of firewood by means of a truck or other transportation facility, customarily used in delivering firewood to such consumer, even though such delivery bring the total amount of fuels in the consumer's possession to more than the amounts to which he would be entitled under paragraph c.

For purposes of determining the amount of fuel on hand and estimated annual fuel needs under this section, a ton of coal and a cord or unit of firewood shall be deemed of equal value.

Local Man Killed In Cycle Crash

A private service was held at the Chapman Funeral Home, by Rev. H. J. Gieseke, on Saturday afternoon. After this service the body was shipped to Sebeca, Minnesota, for final rites and interment. He is survived by his mother, three sisters and two brothers.

Oregon's New Law for Motorists in a Nutshell

Check these questions and answers and see how they apply to you.

- Q. Does this new law require everyone to carry insurance?
A. No.
- Q. Suppose I don't carry any. What can happen to me?
A. Nothing — unless you have an accident.
- Q. Then what happens?
A. Your drivers' license and car plates are automatically suspended until you take out a bond, or cash — or take out insurance — to guarantee that you will pay for any damage you may do in the future.
- Q. Suppose the accident isn't my fault
A. It doesn't matter. The other fellow may be driving recklessly, in violation of law, and crash into your car in spite of everything you can do to prevent it. Still, you must furnish evidence of financial responsibility before you can drive again.
- Q. What happens to the fellow who is held to be at fault?
A. He must, in addition to furnishing evidence of financial responsibility for the future, pay for the damage and injuries already caused before his license can be reinstated.
- Q. Well, if I do have an accident I don't expect to be to blame. Why not wait and take out the insurance only if I have an accident and am required to do so?
A. Insurance is much cheaper and easier to obtain before you have an accident than afterward. By taking it out now you are not only protected against claims by others — legitimate and otherwise — but are automatically relieved of delays and penalties imposed under the new law.
- Q. Suppose I am covered by insurance and have an accident. What do I do?
A. Report the accident immediately to your insurance broker so that he can send the Secretary of State a certified report or statement of your insurance coverage. This automatically relieves you of any further responsibility.
- Q. How expensive is this form of insurance?
A. Not very. It depends on your gas ration card. For an A card it is \$12.75; for a B card, \$13.50; and for a C card, \$14.50, in the Sandy territory.
