dropped somewhat this year, but the increase just authorized will allow for slightly more soap per capita than in prewar years. There is no basis for "scare buying," the War Food administration assures housewives.

Even so, soap supplies will not be excessive, so careful conservation is still necessary. Supplies will be increased, but so will demands. Military and industrial needs are greater, and large supplies soon will be needed in the manufacture of synthetic rubber.

The new soap program was discussed at a recent meeting of the War Food administration's soap and glycerine industry advisory committee, which expected increased production to get under way around October 1st, and to get to the shelves of retail stores by November.

Instruction in military science and tactics was begun at the college in 1872, but the first U. S. army officer was detailed to the college in 1894.

First professor of agriculture was Edgar Grimm, appointed in 1883. First bulletin of the agricultural experiment station, established in 1887, was published in 1888 on the subject "History and Organization" by Grimm.

In the first year of Dr. Kerr's presidency these things happened: entrance requirements raised and preparatory department abolished; new calendar adopted; instructional division organized into schools; summer school started; two buildings erected and Olmstead campus plans prepared.

No Reason to Hoard Soap Stock

A 28 per cent increase in all soaps produced for civilian use result from a recent War Food administration order, announces Lois A. Lutz, extension specialist in home management. More fats and oils are being allocated for this purpose, though manufacturers are being requested to use prescribed percentages of non-fat materials as substitutes for fats.
