Game Commission

Makes Few Changes

applies also to jack salmon, striped bass, shad, and sturgeon. Spiny-rayed fish may be taken the year around except that in Klamath county the season for black bass is closed during May and June.

To the list of closed waters previously announced, the commission added Ennis, Martin and Goose creeks, all tributaries of the McKenzie river.

It was decided to leave the bag limit for East Lake in Deschutes county the same as it was last year, 10 fish, instead of five fish as tentatively announced before. The commission decided to assign a biologist to study conditions at East and Paulina lakes, and also one for Diamond lake so that more adequate information can be obtained for future management policies. It is also planned to study conditions at Owyhee reservoir before taking action on the local recommendation for an early trout season.

The complete angling regulations for 1946 will be available in printed form and in the hands of license agents for distribution shortly after March 1.

Vet Application

Forms Available

In applying for surplus property the veteran must state that he needs the equipment either in his own business or professional or agricultural enterprise, or that he needs it as a condition of his employment. If he qualifies, SWPC will mail him a pink slip certifying that he has preference over other persons in the purchase of desired equipment.

A duplicate slip goes to the RFC disposal agency, which in turn notifies the veteran when and where the equipment he has

applied for is available.

Surplus property officials in Portland advise veterans not to apply for cars, however, because they said none are available and there is little hope of supplying more than a few of the 2000 applicants already on file for surplus autos. They estimate that probably only one veteran in 10,000 will ever get a surplus car.

Up to January 12, a total of 6884 veteran applications for surplus property was on file in the Portland SWPC office at 815 Bedell building. In December alone, 1536 veterans applied for surplus property. SWPC officials said about \$75,000 worth of equipment a week was going to veterans in Oregon, consisting largely of trucks, tractors, bulldozers and other construction materials.
