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No Smallpox In
County At Present

To those people previously vaccinated who are complaining about their recent vaccination not "taking," Dr. Dan P. Trullinger, county health officer, has the following information.

"Their earlier vaccination gave them their original immunity and after their recent vaccination, a little blister appeared which itched for a day or two then dried up and the local activity subsided. Many are complaining that they did not have a 'take,' this is true but what they did have was just as good in that, it was an 'immune reaction.' This shows that the person still has immunity from his original vaccination. The reaction at this time also serves as a stimulation or booster of that original immunity. Such people do not need further smallpox vaccination for approximately five years. If they have an original scar, and have had a recent re-vaccination, that reacted slightly, they can feel that they do have a high level of immunity to smallpox. Everyone should assure themselves that they do have such immunity. Recent vaccination is the only means of obtaining such assurance."

It is unfortunate that some children recently vaccinated have also developed true red measles (not German measles). True measles often make a child quite ill and when associated with vaccination the child can be expected to be a little more ill. Since serious complications often follow measles, all children having them should have the best of care, the doctor warned.

There have been no cases of smallpox reported in the county, to date, and none in the state. Last year, five cases were reported in Oregon.
