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Surplus Diesels
Sent to Oregon

Diesel engine units intended to drive General Sherman tanks across the battlefields of Europe are being rushed to Oregon for various critical power needs, according to the Portland office of War Assets Administration. Each unit is composed of two engines with a combined normal rating of 260 horsepower but, due to a larger fuel jets used by the army, this has been increased to 375 horsepower. They sell for \$2800 per unit f.o.b. New York.

When 500 were declared surplus this week the Portland inter-regional unit immediately sold 53 and this is believed to be just the beginning. Typical of early buyers were C. W. Priest, Vancouver, Wash., who needed power for a fishing boat, and Hugh Sherwood, Jr., of Toledo, Ore., who is starting a saw mill.
