Notice of School Election Upon Question of Increasing Tax Levy Over Amount Limited by Section 11, Article XI, State Constitution.

The reasons for increasing such levy are: The necessity for an additional teacher; increased salaries for teachers and other employees; To make necessary repairs to buildings and equipment; To purchase additional equipment; Teachers' Retirement Fund; To keep the District on a cash basis.
 The amount of tax, in excess of the 6% limitation, proposed to be levied for said year is \$31,246.38.
