1945-46 Traffic Death Rate Same
Oregon's traffic death rate for the first four months of 1946 was 11 persons killed per one hundred million miles of travel, exactly the same as for the same period of 1945, Secretary of State Robert S. Farrell Jr., said today.
"Thus, while actual deaths are considerably higher than they were a year ago, the death rate, which shows the number of

deaths in relation to the exposure to accident, has not increased," the secretary of state said.
Motor vehicle use during the first four months of 1946 soared to new highs for this state, Farrell said. The month of April, for example, saw the highest gasoline consumption of any one month in the state's history, he declared.

"While Oregon's death rate is not increasing, we are barely holding our own and unless drivers and pedestrians exercise greater care, the death rate may start moving upward, as motor vehicle use continues to climb," Farrell said.

Earl Bell, next year student body president of Sandy Union high school, played in the "all-state baseball" game held at the Portland Beavers stadium Saturday, June 8. Earl played left field without an error and accounted for one of the three hits collected by his team, the upstate all stars.

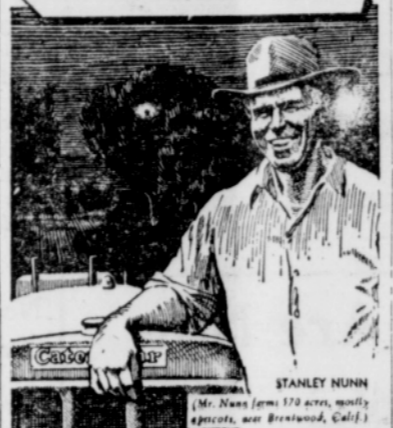
