Garage Equipment Offered For Sale

A huge national stock of garage and service station equipment was announced for sale today by the Portland War Assets office. Federal agencies and qualified veterans will have until July 1 to exercise their priorities after which sales will be made to normal trade channels. Maintenance, lubrication and tire servicing equipment is offered.

Portland's inter-regional section today received word that it can get a considerable number of items needed in this area from the Salt Lake City inventory. These include electric generators from three to 30 kilowatts, lead covered wire, hydraulic presses and pneumatic wood drills.

One hundred gallon chlorinators, suitable for small communities and camps, are now available.

Information has been received that various types of bridges, including the famous Bailey bridges, bridge sections and component parts are available from various WAA offices.
