1946 Hunting Regulations Adopted

The 1946 hunting regulations were finally adopted by the Oregon state game commission on July 27.

The general deer season will extend from September 28 to October 25 inclusive, with a bag limit of one deer having not less than forked antlers. Five special antlerless deer seasons have been authorized on problem ranges.

The general elk season will extend from October 29 to November 20 inclusive in eastern Oregon and close one week earlier in western Oregon. The bag limits differ by areas.

Two small special elk seasons have been authorized on problem elk ranges in eastern Oregon.

The upland game bird season will extend from October 19 to 27 in most counties with a bag limit of 3 cock pheasants and 5 valley quail. The season will extend to November 2 in Malheur

county and will not open in the Willamette valley counties.

The closing date for applications for licenses to hunt in the special big-game seasons will be accepted until 5 p. m. August 21. After which time drawings will be held and successful applicants notified. (No person shall be entitled to receive more than one special deer license and elk license). License fees remain the same as last year except that the special deer licenses will be \$5 for residents and \$25 for non-residents.

All hunters will be required to check in and out of special big game hunting areas; and no person shall possess any game birds or game animals in an area in which the season is closed or inconsistent unless said birds or animals have been properly tagged within the area in which they were legally taken.

Gun regulations remain the same as last year except that the military M-1 carbines and Garand and Johnson automatic rifle and machine guns have been banned for hunting.

No person shall possess or transport any game animals or game birds in or to an area in which the season for such species, number or sex of animals or birds is closed or inconsistent unless said animals or birds have been affixed with the approved seal of the game commission within the area in which they were legally taken.

All electors residing within the City of Sandy and all electors residing within the said territory to be annexed are invited to vote at their respective voting places on the proposition of whether said territory shall be annexed to and become a part of the City of Sandy. Those in favor should mark their ballot X "For Annexation" and those not in favor of the proposition should mark their ballot X "Against Annexation."

Verona Schneider and Helen Dahrens shall be the judges and Edna Scales, Dorothy Mills and Hazel Brown shall be the clerks of said special election at the City Hall in Sandy, Oregon, and Floyd Light and Matilda Jonsrud shall be the judges, and William Priebe, Henry Helms and Augusta Bruns shall be the clerks of such special election at the Sandy High School.

Pursuant to said resolution a special election will be held in the City Hall in the City of Sandy, Clackamas County, Oregon, and at the residence of J. Krieger, on Langerson Road, within the hereinafter described territory, a portion of Clackamas County, Oregon, to determine whether or not that portion of said Clackamas County which is described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land located in Section 13, Township 2 South, Range 4 East of the Willamette Meridian, and in Section 18, Township 2 South, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the southeast corner of the present city limits (1946) of the City of Sandy, Oregon, which corner is the northeast corner of the Southeast one-quarter of said Section 13; from said beginning point thence West following the south city limit boundary of said city to the northwest corner of the East one-half of the Southeast one-quarter of said Section 13; thence South, following the north and south division line of the said Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of said Section 13; thence East, following the south boundary of said Section 13, to the section corner common to Sections 13 and 24, Township 2 South, Range 4 East of the Willamette Meridian, and Sections 18 and 19, Township 2 South, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence continuing East, following the south boundary of said Section 18, a distance of 660.00 feet; thence North, parallel with the west bound-
